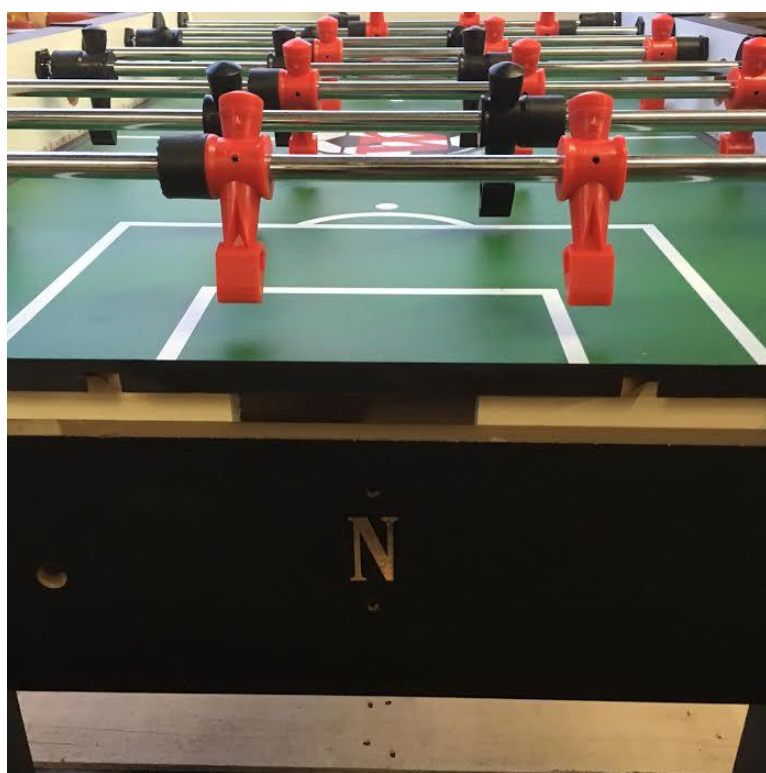


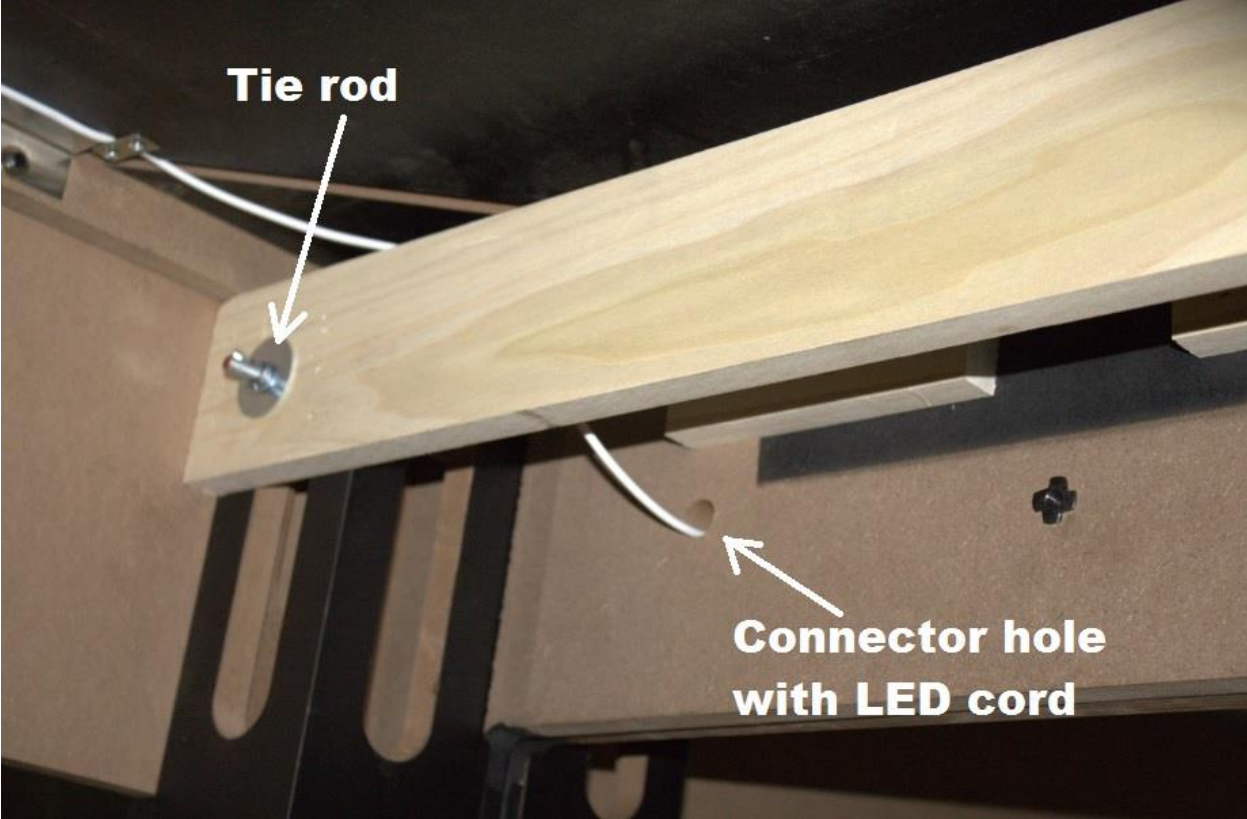
Connecting Multiple Tables

Line up Tables coordinated by the letters labeled on each table. For example “A” will connect to “A”, “B” will connect to “B” and so on. Most table letters will be at random. Here is a photo for reference.



Underneath each table will have a solid Poplar 1 x 4 board approx. 30 inches in length with a hole on each end. Once you have the coordinated tables butted up to each other properly you will simply use the TIE RODS provided in the packing box to connect each table. We have provided wing nuts for a more simple tightening method.

There is also WHITE LED CONNECTORS hanging from each end. Once connected and tightened properly simply take the longer connector and pull it through the provided hole to connect to the other table. Below is a photo of how it should look once everything is properly set up.
