
Important Safety Instructions

IMPORTANT: Read the assembly instruction section and safety precautions of this booklet carefully before removing the contents of this carton.

- 1. In certain circumstances electrical appliances may be a safety hazard.
- 2. Do not try to use the cooker hood without the grease filters or if the filters are excessively greasy!
- 3. Do not install above a cooker with a high-level grill.
- 4. Do not leave frying pans unattended during use because overheated fats or oils might catch fire.
- 5. Never leave naked flames under the cooker hood.
- 6. If the cooker hood is damaged, do not attempt to use.
- 7. Do not flambé under the cooker hood.
- 8. CAUTION: Accessible parts may become hot when used with cooking appliances.
- 9. The range hood must be mounted at a minimum distance of 60cm above the cooking surface.
- 10. The air must not be discharged into a flue that is used for exhausting fumes from appliances burning gas or other fuels. Rangehoods and other cooking fume extractors may adversely affect the safe operation of appliances burning gas or other fuels (including those in other rooms) due to back flow of combustion gases. These gases can potentially result in carbon monoxide poisoning. After installation of a range hood or other cooking fume extractor, the operation of open flued gas appliances should be tested by a competent person to ensure that back flow of combustion gases does not occur.
- 11. Important! Always switch off the electricity supply at the mains during installation and maintenance such as light bulb replacement.
- 12. The cooker hood must be installed in accordance with the installation instructions and all measurements followed.
- 13. All installation work must be carried out by a competent person or qualified electrician.
- 14. Please dispose of the packing material carefully. Children are vulnerable to it.
- 15. Pay attention to the sharp edges inside the cooker hood especially during installation and cleaning.
- 16. Make sure the ducting has no bends sharper than 90 degrees as this will reduce the efficiency of the cooker hood.
- 17. Warning: Failure to install the screws or fixing device in accordance with these instructions may result in electrical hazards.
- 18. Warning: Before obtaining access to terminals, all supply circuits must be disconnected.
- 19. Always put lids on pots and pans when cooking on a gas cooker.
- 20. When in extraction mode, air in the room is being removed by the cooker hood. Please make sure that proper ventilation measures are being observed. The cooker hood removes odours from room but not steam.
- 21. There shall be adequate ventilation of the room when the cooker hood is used at the same time as appliances burning gas or other fuels.
- 22. Cooker hood is for domestic use only.
- 23. If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid a hazard.
- 24. This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience or knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning the use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety. Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.
- 25. There is a fire risk if cleaning is not carried out in accordance with the instructions.
- 26. Regulations concerning the discharge of air have to be fulfilled.
- 27. For safety reason, please use only the same size of fixing or mounting screw which are recommended in this instruction manual.
- 28. Regarding the details about the method and frequency of cleaning, please refer to maintenance and cleaning section in the instruction manual.
- 29. Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be made by children without supervision.
- When the cooker hood and appliances supplied with energy other than electricity are simultaneously in operation, the negative pressure in the room must not exceed $4 \text{ Pa}(4 \times 10^{-5} \text{ bar})$.
- 31. WARNING: Danger of fire: Do not store items on the cooking surfaces.
- 32. A steam cleaner is not to be used.
- 33. NEVER try to extinguish a fire with water but switch off the appliance and then cover flame e.g., with a lid or a fire blanket.



INSTALLATION (VENT OUTSIDE)


If you have an outlet to the outside, your cooker hood can be connected as below picture by means of an
extraction duct (enamel, aluminum, flexible pipe, or non-flammable material with an interior diameter of
120mm)



• Before installation, turn the unit off and unplug it from the outlet.




• The cooker hood should be placed at a distance of 60~75cm above the cooking plane for best effect.



METHOD A:


- 1. To install onto the wall, drill 4 holes of \emptyset 8mm on a suitable place according with the centre distance of hole in the back of the cooker hood. See below picture.
- 2. Insert the nut into the holes.
- 3. Insert the screws into the nuts and tight.
- 4. Put up the cooker hood onto the fixed screws.
- 5. Then use the attached accessories enclosed to turn the screws into the two holes of inside the hood, and then fix the screws to tighten the hood onto the wall.
- 6. Put the outlet onto the cooker hood.



Installation Instructions

METHOD B:


- 1. Drill 4 holes of Ø 6mm at the bottom of the hanging cupboard.
- 2. Put the outlet to the cooker hood, then install the cooker hood on the bottom of the cupboard, tighten the cooker hood with enclosed 4 screws.
- 3. Install the adjusted board on the bottom of the hood in order to keep out the gap between hood back and cupboard. See below picture.




Note: There are 2 methods for ventilation, including 'horizontal ventilation' and 'vertical ventilation'. Please pay attention to the ventilation method when installation.

Horizontal ventilation: See pic A, please use the cover to seal the outlet on the top, then the air can be vented from back.

Vertical ventilation: See pic B, please use the cover to seal the outlet on the back, then the air can be vented from top.






AIR VENTILATION SETTING

Outdoor air ventilation: Turn the adjuster to outdoor position (pic A below), install the outlet, turn on the cooker hood, then the air will be vented from the outside outlet.

Indoor air ventilation: Turn the adjuster to indoor position (pic B below), install the outlet cover, turn on the cooker hood, then the air can be vented from the inside outlet.



Operating Instructions

START USING YOUR COOKER HOOD

- 1. Push the stop button, and the motor will stop.
- 2. Push the low button, and the motor will start running at low speed.
- 3. Push the mid button, and the motor will start running at medium speed.
- 4. Push the high button, and the motor will start running at high speed.
- 5. Push the lamp button and the two lights will illuminate. Push it again and the lights will turn off.



TROUBLESHOOTING

Fault	Possible Cause	Solution
	Fan switch turned off	Select a fan switch position.
Light on, but motor does not work	Fan switch failed	Contact service center.
adda not work	Motor failed	Contact service center.
	House fuses blown	Reset/Replace fuses.
Light does not work; motor does not work	Mains power cable is loose or disconnected	Refit mains power cable to power outlet. Switch power outlet on.
Oil leakage	One way valve and the outlet are not tightly sealed	Take down the one-way valve and seal with sealant.
	Leakage from the connection of chimney and cover	Take chimney down and seal.
Lights not working	Broken or faulty bulbs	Replace bulbs as per this instruction.
Insufficient suction	The distance between the cooker hood and the gas top is too far	Refit the cooker hood to the correct distance.
The Cooker hood inclines	The fixing screw is not tight enough	Tighten the hanging screw and make it horizontal.

Any electrical repairs to this appliance must conform to your local, state and federal laws. Please contact the service center if in any doubt before undertaking any of the above. Always disconnect the unit from the power source when opening the unit.



Cleaning and Maintenance

CAUTION:


• Before maintenance or cleaning is carried out, the cooker hood should be disconnected from the mains power supply. Ensure that the cooker hood is switched off at the wall socket and the plug removed.



- External surfaces are susceptible to scratches and abrasions, so follow the cleaning instructions to ensure the best possible result is achieved without damage.
- Cleaning and maintenance should be carried out with the appliance cold especially when cleaning. Avoid leaving alkaline or acid substances (lemon juice, vinegar etc.) on the surfaces.
- The stainless steel must be cleaned regularly (e.g., Weekly) to ensure a long-life expectancy. Dry with a clean, soft cloth. A specialized stainless steel cleaning fluid may be used.
- Ensure that wiping is done along with the grain of the stainless steel to prevent any unsightly crisscross scratching patterns from appearing.
- The inlay control panel can be cleaned using warm soapy water. Ensure the cloth is clean and well wrung before cleaning. Use a dry soft cloth to remove any excess moisture left after cleaning.
- Using neutral detergents and avoid using harsh cleaning chemicals, strong household detergents or products
 containing abrasives, as this will affect the appearance of the appliance and potentially remove any printing of
 artwork on the control panel and will void manufactures warrantee.

GREASE MESH FILTERS

The mesh filters can be cleaned by hand. Soak them for about 3 minutes in water with a mild detergent and then brush it gently with a soft brush. Do not apply too much pressure to avoid any damage to it. (Leave to dry naturally out of direct sun light) Filters should be washed separately to crockery and kitchen utensils. It is advisable not to use rinse aid.



INSTALLING GREASE MESH FILTERS

To install filters for the following four steps:

- Angle the filter into the slots at the back of the hood.
- Push the button on the handle of the filter.
- Release the handle once the filter fits into a resting position.
- Repeat to install all filters.


CARBON FILTER

Activated carbon filter can be used to trap odors. Normally the activated carbon filter should be changed every 3 to 6 months according to your cooking habits. The installation procedure of activated carbon filter is as below:

- 1. Before installing or replacing the carbon filters, please remove power to the unit.
- 2. Press the filter lock and remove the mesh filter.
- 3. Turn the carbon filter on both side of the motor anti-clockwise. Replace the carbon filters with new carbon filters.
- 4. Place the mesh filter.
- 5. Connect the power supply to the wall socket.


NOTE:

- Make sure the filter is securely locked. Otherwise, it would loosen and cause danger.
- When activated carbon filter attached, the suction power will be lowered.


BULB REPLACEMENT:

NOTE:

- The bulb must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent or similarly qualified persons.
- Always switch off the electricity supply before carrying out any operations on the appliance. When handling bulb, make sure it has completely cooled down before any direct contact with hands.
- When handling bulbs hold with a cloth or gloves to ensure perspiration does not come in contact with the bulb as this can reduce the life of the bulb.
- 1. Remove the grease filter.
- 2. Use a screwdriver to remove the wire cover.
- 3. Put the lamp outwards by hand, remove the wire terminal to replace the lights.
- 4. Apply the reverse procedure to reinstall the lights.

Laundry Tub - 5 years on stainless bowl, 24 months on Tap, Cabinet and other components from the date of original purchase for domestic use.

- 2.
