

Installation Instructions


Important Notes:


- The G Force Jeep fuel regulator delete kit allows the user to delete the OEM Jeep fuel pressure regulator (set at about 40 PSI) and install an external regulator of his/ her choice.
- A noteworthy feature of this kit includes: no drilling into your tank necessary for the return fitting. This billet aluminum adapter has a return port built in!
- Utilizes an O-ring seal to the sending unit.
- Uses the stock Jeep regulator retaining clip.
- Comes with hose barb fittings and will require fuel injection rated hoses and clamps to install (not included).



Installation Steps

- 1. Start by dropping your gas tank and disconnecting the stock fuel lines.
- 2. Remove the threaded collar holding the sending unit to the tank.
- 3. Make sure there is no debris to fall into the open tank. Some compressed air to the top of the tank should do the trick. Remove stock sending unit.
- 4. Pop off the steel retaining clip holding the stock regulator in place (this will be reused).
- 5. Remove stock regulator. Now would be a good time to replace the OEM fuel pump.
- 6. Disassemble the top half of the sending unit.





- 7. Using a pair of snips, followed by a step drill, open up the return port on the sending unit top as shown in the photos above. Take care not to crack the plastic.
- 8. Install hose barb fittings to the regulator delete. Do not forget to use Teflon tape on the threads.

- 9. Lubricate the o-ring and Insert the small diameter of the delete assembly into the plastic ID of the top of the sending unit.
- 10. Attach fuel injection hose to the fuel pump and drop it down into the sending unit with appropriate length of hose to reach the hose barb on the delete assembly.



- 11. Attach hose to the hose barb and secure with fuel injection hose clamp.
- 12. Reassemble sending unit and drop back into the tank and install threaded collar.
- 13. We have found that in order to easily install fuel injection hose to the upper hose barbs, you should keep the regulator delete clip off until after the hoses are installed.
- 14. Install retaining clip and run your hoses to the regulator of your choice
