# SURFACE PREPARATION

- All surfaces should be thoroughly clean and dry prior to applying ProCare® Wood & Masonry Sealer. Existing surface dirt, mildew, mold, oil, tar, grease, chemical films and other stains should be removed from surface by approved methods varying by substrate.
- For best cleaning results, use ProCare® Mold & Mildew Stain Remover or ProCare® Concentrated Degreaser.
- After cleaning, wait at least 4-6 hours before applying sealer on wood. Note: Always allow concrete or masonry surfaces 1 to 3 days to dry before application. New concrete or masonry walls should cure a minimum of 7 days before sealer application.
- Perform a trial test to ensure compatibility. Surface may darken slightly during application. Color appearance is different when fully

## APPLICATION PROCEDURES

- Mix ProCare® Wood & Masonry Sealer well before use.
- Apply using a pump/airless sprayer, paint pad, brush, or roller. If using a pump up sprayer, back brushing may be required to even out the sealer.
- ProCare® Wood & Masonry Sealer should be applied evenly until surface is completely saturated. 3.
- Heavy runs and drips should be thoroughly bruished into the surface. Avoid over application.
- On extremely porous substrates, a second coat can be applied. Allow a few minutes for first coat to penetrate and appear dry before additional coat is applied. Avoid puddling.

NOTE: Overuse of this product may leave a waxy surface. For best results, clean off heavy residue. Overspray can be washed off while still wet or removed with the use of mineral spirits if dry. This will usually correct itself overtime.

## PREVENTION & RESPONSE

Wash hands thoroughly. Wear protective gloves as well as eye and face protection. IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with clean, lukewarm water for at least 15 minutes while holding eyelids open. If wearing contacts, remove them. Seek medical attention if irritation persists.
