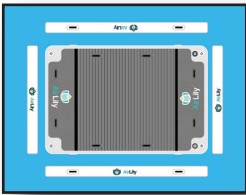
# **Inflatable DOCK User Manual**

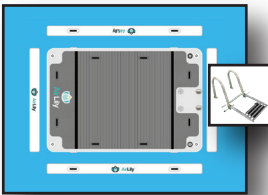
# **WARNING**

Failure to read, understand, and comply with the information in this document could result in personal injury or damages to this product. **Do not throw this out.** Please keep for future reference.

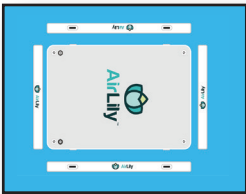

## Inflation:

- Gently pull out and completely unroll your Air Lily. Make sure to do this on a flat / clear surface free of sharp objects and debris.
- Ensure it is right side up with air valve facing up.
- Remove inflation valve cap and check that valve stem is closed before inflating so air isn't released while pumping.
- Insert and twist dual action hand pump hose into the inflation valve and begin filling with air.
- Inflate to the recommended air pressure of 5 PSI.
- **Note:** Hand pump pressure gauge will not begin registering air levels until the paddle board has reached a certain level - 5 PSI. So keep pumping!
- **NEVER** inflate beyond 10 PSI.
- When ready: Put on valve cap, place Air Lily in the water with help from another person and enjoy! Never drag on the ground.

*Note: If using an electric pump, be extra careful not to over inflate. We suggest filling most of the way with an electric pump, and then to finish off inflation with the dual action hand pump.*

**NOTE: Never use an air compressor to fill up an Air Lily**

## Deflation:

- Remove Air Lily from the water and place on a flat / clear surface free of sharp objects and debris.
- Ensure it is right side up with air valve facing up.
- Remove inflation valve cap and click/twist the valve stem to begin releasing air. Use the dual action hand pump to fully deflate (if needed).

## Storage:

- Clean off Air Lily before long term storage with water, mild soap, and a soft brush. Never use chemical cleaners or a pressure washer.
- Ensure Air Lily is completely dry before rolling up and placing in bag. This will protect it from mold and mildew build up.
- Store in provided pack bag and place in a cool/dry area free of sharp objects and debris.
- Paddle board can also be stored inflated.
- Do not store/leave in direct sunlight for long periods of time.

**NOTE: Never fold Air Lily. Always roll up for packing.**

- Do not use this product without competent, adult supervision
- Do not use this product while under the influence of drugs or alcohol
- All users must wear a life jacket
- Use common sense while using this product
- Do not use in inclement weather or dangerous environments
- Do not tow
- Do not modify this product in any way as issues may arise
- Never dive headfirst off product or swim underneath product
- Ensure product is anchored properly before use (Do not anchor to docks or other hard/sharp surfaces, as this can be damaging)
- Use product "D-Rings" for securing anchors to
- Never use handles for securing
- Always know your surroundings before using this product. It is meant to be used in large bodies of water, free from objects/hazards, and at a minimum depth of 5 feet.
- Never use on land
- Always inspect product before use to ensure safety
