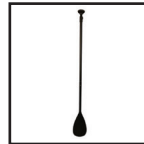
Inflatable Paddle Board User Manual

**IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS
READ AND FOLLOW ALL INSTRUCTIONS**

WARNING

Please read this user manual before operating your new Air Lily. This document contains important information about the safe use and operation of this product. Failure to read, understand, and comply with the information in this document could result in personal injury or damages to this product. **Do not throw this out.** Please keep for future reference.

Package Contents:



- *Air Lily*
- *Backpack*
- *Single Action Hand Pump*

- *Repair Kit*
- *Paddle*
- *Leash and Fins*

Inflation:

- Gently pull out and completely unroll your Air Lily. Make sure to do this on a flat / clear surface free of sharp objects and debris.
- Attach and secure large middle fin.
- Ensure it is right side up with air valve facing up (fins facing down).
- Remove inflation valve cap and check that valve stem is closed before inflating so air isn't released while pumping.
- Insert and twist hand pump hose into the inflation valve and begin filling with air.
- Inflate to the recommended air pressure of **15 PSI**.
- **Note:** Hand pump pressure gauge will not begin registering air levels until the paddle board has reached a certain level - **5 PSI**. So keep pumping!
- **NEVER** inflate beyond **20 PSI**.
- Attach leash provided to the "D-Ring" at the back end of the board.
- Never drag on the ground.
- When ready: Put on valve cap, grab the paddle provided, place Air Lily in the water, and enjoy!

NOTE: Never use an air compressor to fill up an Air Lily

Deflation:

- Remove Air Lily from the water and place on a flat / clear surface free of sharp objects and debris.
- Remove large middle fin and leash. Place in backpack.
- Ensure it is right side up with air valve facing up.
- Remove inflation valve cap and click/twist the valve stem to begin releasing air. Ensure the valve stem remains open so that air continues to be released as you roll the board up.
- Start rolling (**never fold**) the board up from the nose (**with the top deck being on the inside**) to the back end.
- The 2 smaller fins (**that cannot be removed**) will be at the very end and on the outside of the roll to avoid any damage.

Storage:

- Clean off Air Lily before long term storage with water, mild soap, and a soft brush. Never use chemical cleaners or a pressure washer.
- Ensure Air Lily is completely dry before rolling up and placing in bag. This will protect it from mold and mildew build up.
- Store in provided backpack and place in a cool/dry area free of sharp objects and debris.
- Paddle board can also be stored inflated.
- Do not store/leave in direct sunlight for long periods of time.

NOTE: Never fold Air Lily. Always roll up for packing.
