# You're almost done!

Thanks so much for your purchase! We've already assembled most of the table. You just have to connect the legs.

### WHAT'S INCLUDED



## INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Place the tabletop upside-down on the ground on top of a blanket, carpet, or the foam sheet it was shipped in to prevent the surface from being scratched.
- **2.** Attach the table legs to the tabletop with the provided screws and holes.
- **3.** Connect the control cables to the legs (they look like ethernet cables). Push any excess cable into the storage compartment so there's little slack.



- **4**. Plug in the power cord to a power outlet.
- **5.** To initiate the electronics, press the down button for a few seconds until the legs move up and down.
- 6. With the legs all the way down and the drawers secure, flip the table right-side-up. The table's ready to go!

### SETTING PRE-SET HEIGHTS

- 1. Adjust table to the desired height.
- 2. Press the memory icon (either S or M) and then one of the three shortcut buttons (1, 2, or 3) to store the position.
- 3. Press the shortcut button to set the table at that height.

# WOOD CARE TIPS

- Protect wood from hot surfaces and moisture. Use coasters.
- Reapply wax when wood starts to look dull. If you notice the wood getting dull over the years, you can reapply a light layer of food-save wax (like Howard's Wax).



## CABLE MANAGEMENT TIPS

- Attach a power strip with at least 4-5 outlets (or one for each of your electronic devices plus one more to power the table) underneath the table using industrial-strength double-sided tape. Make sure you don't obstruct the slot where cables come down from the tabletop. Plugging in the power strip will then power the table and all your electronics.
- Tuck excess cables into the metal tray on the sides. Use provided velcro cable wrappers to shorten the cable so there's no slack.
