



Installation Instructions for the JK 4-Door Rear Windshield

1. With the finished black fabric facing the rear of the Jeep, slide the long round plastic base of the windshield through the "C" channel that is attached to the BackBone along the back of the rear seats. This is done easier with 2 people feeding a little bit at a time. If you "pull" the windshield be careful not to rip the stitching.
2. Make sure the Windshield is centered in the "C" channel.
3. Loosely wrap all of the straps around the rear and side roll bars. The straps go OVER the roll bar, around and under, then through the buckle and attached to the Velcro. **DO NOT TIGHTEN THE STRAPS AT THIS POINT!**
4. Tuck the horizontal plastic piece of the side windows underneath the outside lip of the frame of the Jeep (the same way you would attach a soft top window).
5. Tuck the vertical plastic piece of the side windows into the vertical plastic door surrounds where the rear doors close (the same way you would attach a soft top window).
6. Moving back and forth, tighten all of the straps around the roll bars.
7. As the weather changes and the fabric relaxes and flexes, some tightening of the straps may be necessary over time.
