He founded the Gas Station, at East 2nd and B, and is cofounder of the "Rivington School" (both seminal downtown epicenters of art activity and sprawling sculptural installation in the 80's and 90's). He is an artist of great import with a loyal, base of passionate collectors and is seen in numerous parts of the city of NYC and the World. As a contemporary of Baquiat, Futura 2000, George Condo (sculptures), Rammellzee, Willie Cole, John Chamberlain, and Mark Di Suvero, his work confounds, and fascinates with it's exacting intricacies and an only– NYC– downtown punk rock sensibility.
