#### **Details**

**Target Description** Potassium voltage-gated channel subfamily Q member 1 is encoded by the gene KCNQ1. KCNQ1 is

a member of the potassium channel family, KQT (TC 1.A.1.15) subfamily, Kv7.1/KCNQ1 subsubfamily. KCNQ1 is a voltage-gated potassium channel that is required for the repolarization phase of the cardiac action potential. KCNQ1 can form heteromultimers with two other potassium channel proteins, KCNE1 and KCNE3. KCNQ1 is expressed in the heart, pancreas, kidney, prostate, small intestine, and peripheral blood leukocytes. Diseases associated with KCNQ1 include Long QT Syndrome1, Jervell and Lange-Nielsen Syndrome, atrial fibrillation familial 3, short QT syndrome 2,

and atrial fibrillation.

**Specificity** No cross-reactivity reported

**Purification Method** Produced by in vitro bioreactor culture of hybridoma line followed by Protein A affinity

chromatography and conjugation of purified mAb. Purified mAbs are >90% specific antibody.

Quality Control Tests Each new lot of antibody is quality control tested on cells overexpressing target protein and

confirmed to give the expected staining pattern.

# Storage

Aliquot and store at  $\leq$  -20°C for long term storage. For short term storage, store at 2-8°C. For maximum recovery of product, centrifuge the vial prior to removing the cap.
