Target Description	Short transient receptor potential channel 7 or TrpC7 is encoded by the TRPC7. TrpC7 belongs to the transient receptor family, a group of membrane bound ion channels that have a relatively non-selective permeability to cations, including sodium, calcium and magnesium. TrpC7 is expressed in heart, lung, eye, and pituitary gland.

Purification Method	Produced by in vitro bioreactor culture of hybridoma line followed by Protein A affinity chromatography and conjugation of purified mAb. Purified mAbs are >90% specific antibody.
Quality Control Tests	Each new lot of antibody is quality control tested by western blot on rat whole brain lysate and confirmed to stain the expected molecular weight band.
Storage	Aliquot and store at ≤ -20°C for long term storage. For short term storage, store at 2-8°C. For
