Details Target Description	Potassium inwardly rectifying channel subfamily J member 9 is encoded by the gene KCNJ9. KCNJ9 is a member of the inward rectifier-type potassium channel (TC 1.A.2.1) family, KCNJ9 subfamily. KCNJ9 is an integral membrane protein and inward-rectifier type potassium channel, which has a greater tendency to allow potassium to flow into the cell rather than out of the cell. KCNJ9 is controlled by G-proteins and associates with another G-protein-activated potassium channel to form a heteromultimeric pore-forming complex. KCNJ9 is expressed in the brain and skeletal muscle. Diseases associated with KCNJ9 include Pendred Syndrom and Seizures, Sensorineural Deafness, Ataxia, Mental Retardation, and Electrolyte Imbalance.
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Storage
