Bluetooth




Carry Bag

- Plug the other end into a USB charging port of your power source or computer.
- 3 The red LED-light will indicate that your Franklin is charging.
- When your Franklin is fully charged, the red LED-light will turn off.


- Blue LED-light indicating activity. 2 Multi-Functional Wheel.





Troubleshooting

No power: Ensure your Franklin is charged and has enough power for use. Please note that your Franklin works while charging as well. No sound: Ensure your Franklin is on.

Ensure your Bluetooth device is on. If the volume of the Franklin is too low, adjust the volume to an appropriate level. Unable to connect: Turn off your Franklin and turn it back on. Your Franklin will go into pairing mode. Select 'Franklin'

reconnect. Poor sound quality: Ensure placing your Franklin and your Bluetooth device in a range of 3.3ft (10 meter) sensing distance. Accordingly, be sure to check that there
