


Thank you for purchasing the VIEW Projector and welcome to the world of TRNDlabs products.

Parts Identification




Functions

- 5. Indicator Light


3. Source


6. Focus Adjustment Handle

Connection

- **USB-C:** For mobile power supply, like a power bank
- HDMI: For connection to a PC or TV
- AV: For connection to TV (video and audio)
- Headphone Jack: For earphones
- USB: Insert removable storage disk or other local storage
- DC IN: For power supply

Setup

- Insert the Power Adapter into the DC IN port on the back of the projector and insert the other end into a wall socket.
- The indicator light on top of the projector will light up, indicating that it is ready to turn on.
- 3 Turn the projector on by pressing the On/Off button on the projector or the Power button on the remote.
- To turn the projector off, press the On/Off button on the projector or the Power button on the remote.

How to Use

 After turning the projector on, a user interface will appear in 2 to 5 seconds.

Play media from local storage

- Connect your local storage device with the projector using the USB port.
- Press 'Source' on the remote control or press the 'Source' button on top of the projector
- Select 'MediaPlayer'.
- In the menu navigate to Movie, Music, or Photo and select the files you want to play.

Connect with AV or HDMI

- Connect your PC or TV to the Projector using the HDMI or the AV cable.
- Press 'Source' on the remote control or press the 'Source' button on top of the projector.
- Select 'AV' or 'HDMI', depending on the input used to connect your device.
- If the source is selected and the projector is connected, the screen of the device will be projected after a few seconds.

Settings

- To enter the settings menu, press the 'Settings' button on top of the projector.
- Navigate with the arrows to the left and right to switch between:
 - · General Settings
 - · Image Settings
 - · Time Settings
 - · Audio Settings

Troubleshooting

Problem: My PC is connected via HDMI to the projector, but it does not project the screen.

Solution: Check if the right source is selected. Press on 'Source' and select HDMI.

Solution: Go to the settings of the PC and check if the projector is selected as screen.

Problem: The projector is not playing the sound that belongs to the audio or video file.

Solution: Go to the settings of the device you are connected to and select the projector as audio output device.

Problem: The text in the projector's menu is not the language I prefer.

Solution: Go to settings. In the general settings menu select 'Language', and choose the preferred language out of 23 languages.

Safety Information

- Do not use the projector near water or in wet places. Do not place water filled with liquids, such as vases, close to the projector.
- Do not expose the projector to dripping or splashing.
- Keep the projector away from open fire.
- The projector should be placed on a stable, flat surface. Do not expose the projector to shocks or falls.
- The placement of the projector should not block the ventilation.
- Do not place on soft surfaces like a bed or a sofa, or in a small space where its ventilation is blocked.
- Do not place the projector close to heat sources such as radiators.
- Do not connect the projector to a power supply other than the one that comes with the product (DC12V-1.5A).
- Do not clean using cleaners or detergents. Clean by wiping with a dry and clean cloth.
- Do not clean product while being turned on.
- Do not leave the projector plugged in, when not being used for a long time.
