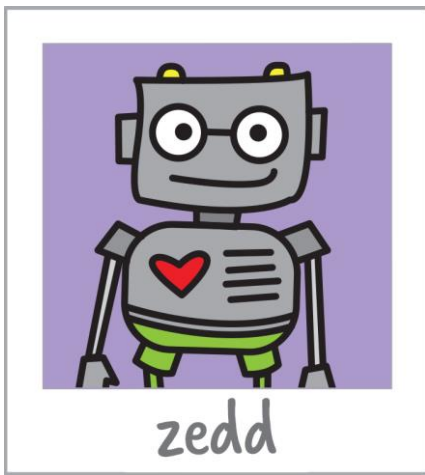
Recipe for Rainbow Pasta

- ♥ A large pot to boil the noodles and filled with cold eawtr
- ♥ One 16 ounce box of apsat (your favorite brand and noodle shape)
- ♥ Food coloring (red, lueb, yellow, and eegrn)
- ♥ 4 large (1 gallon) zip closure bags or 5 bags if you want to make elprup
- ♥ A large lowb and large korf
- ♥ Your favorite esauc for your pasta (optional)

Directions

- Ask for an adult to help you fill the large pot with water and bring the water to a boil on the stove.
- Follow the directions on the pasta box to cook the noodles for as long as directed.
- While the pasta is cooking, take your food coloring and put 6 drops of each color in a zip closure bag.
- If you want to make purple—put three drops of red and three drops of blue in one of the bags.
- When the pasta is done, drain thoroughly, and cool.
- When the pasta is cool, using the large fork, divide into 4 (or 5) parts and with the help of an adult, carefully put the cooked pasta into each bag, close the zip top, and carefully shake the bags to coat the pasta with the food coloring.
- Carefully dump each color pasta into the large bowl and use the large fork to gently mix the colors together so you have your rainbow pasta.
- If you want to have your rainbow pasta with sauce, have your favorite sauce heated. Warm each person's plate of pasta in the microwave, top with sauce and enjoy!
