Quick Guide

From broken to beautiful in 10 easy steps: Please read the safety information on page 7 before use.

STEP I – PREPARATION

Sand away the sharp edges on both sides of all shards with the sanding paper. This way, your golden lines will have a better grip on the rougher surface.

STEP II

After the sanding, make sure all shards are clean, dry and free of dust and grease. Some ethanol or aceton works best for this.

STEP III – MENDING

Open the syringe by turning the grey closure and mix equal small parts on the mixing lid with just a little bit of color powder. Clean the spout of the syringe by wiping away the excess glue before putting the cap back on.

Golden tip:

- Mixture hardens within 5-10 minutes so don't wait too long.
- Too much color powder makes the mixture too dry and reduces the adhesive strength.











STEP IV

Apply a thin and even layer of the Bio glue mixture on only one side of the crack using the spatula, NOT the brush.

STEP V

Wait I minute so the Bio glue can even out nicely and then gently press both parts together. Hold them for a few minutes until the glue is dry but still sticky.

STEP VI

Now use the brush to gently apply extra color powder on the still sticky lines for an extra shiny effect.









STEP VII

To replace too small or missing shards, cut off a small piece of the epoxy kneading paste and knead well until you have one homogeneous mass.

STEP VIII

Fill the missing part with the paste and cut away the excess. After 30min you can add a fine layer of the bio glue mixture so that the whole paste is covered.

Golden tip:

• Once kneaded, the paste dries out within 10 min.











STEP IX – CLEANING

Once your broken object is fully repaired you can use the wooden chisel to remove spillage, residue or undesired lines.

STEP X

After 5-6 hours, you can carefully clean the object with a sponge and mild soap. The bio glue will be completely hardened after 48 hours and is now food safe and dishwasher proof.

Golden tip:

• Never use the rougher side of a sponge as it will damage the final golden layer.

Important info & safety

- Make sure to put on your gloves and protect your workstation.
- Children must always have adult supervision.
- Do not use below 10° Celsius and store in a dry, cool & frost-free place.
- Shelf life: 6 months in closed packaging.

Epoxy putty

A fast drying, super strong 2 components knead mass. Used to fill up cracks..

Premium mica color powder

All color powders are a premium cosmetic grade mica. Do not inhale. Provide adequate ventilation. Keep out of reach of children. Avoid eye & skin contact. In case of contact with eyes, immediately rinse with plenty of water and seek medical attention. If swallowed, seek medical advice immediately.
