- Since 2009, adoption of high-efficiency cogeneration (CAR) plants with an installed capacity of 2.5 MW
- From 2021 transition of the company car fleet to electric mobility
- Certification of the Energy Management System ISO 50001:2018


- Installation of new photovoltaic systems
