## FORM 10 OFF-LICENCE

Sections 17 to 20 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

PURSUANT to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), Jules Taylor Wines Limited is authorised to sell alcohol on the premises situated at 66 Rowley Crescent, Grovetown, Marlborough District and known as "Jules Taylor Wines Limited", to any person for consumption off the premises.

If this licence is not endorsed under section 40 of the Act, the licensee is also authorised to sell alcohol on or from the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

## Endorsement

Section 40 of the Act applies to this licence; and the licensee is authorised to sell alcohol from (but not on) the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

## CONDITIONS

- (a) No alcohol sold is to be delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1.00 pm on Anzac Day, or at any time after 11.00 pm on any day and before 6.00 am on the next day.
- (b) The remote sale of alcohol may be made at any time on any day, however the days and hours within which alcohol that has been sold may be delivered is restricted, as set out in conditions (a) above
- (c) The licensee must implement and maintain the steps proposed in the application for the licence aimed at promoting the responsible consumption of alcohol.
- (d) The licensee, when conducting phone, mail, internet sales (remote sales) must ensure that all the requirements under Section 59 of the Act relating to remote sales are complied with

DISPLAY OF LICENCE A copy of this licence must be displayed on the website where remote sales are conduction from.

## DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force -

- (a)
  - (i) until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
  - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued;
- if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, (b) either
  - until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
  - if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.
