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Introduction

Congratulations on your purchase of the Club LE pedicure chair. The Club LE offers an unparalleled pedicure and hydrotherapy experience, featuring a luxurious, handcrafted chair and a jetted tub. The tub basin is lined with soothing textured foot pebbles to give your client's feet a relaxed, massaging sensation.

The Club LE is designed for licensed therapists and technicians and is intended to be used in a professional spa, salon, or similar commercial environment. While no special training is needed to operate the product, for safety reasons it is important that the instructions contained in this manual are reviewed in detail before the first use. This manual should be read in its entirety by each professional who will be operating the product to ensure the safety of both operator and client. This manual should be saved for future reference.

The Club LE should not be used in any other manner than described in this manual. Please read, understand, and follow all safety warnings, labels, and instructions. Misuse, use of unnecessary force, or using the chair for unintended or unauthorized procedures can result in injury to operator, client, and/or equipment.

- DO NOT stand on or in the basin, or on the foot rest.
- DO NOT leave this appliance unattended when in operation.
- DO NOT use outdoors.
- DO NOT retract tub when water is in basin.
- Keep the electrical cord away from heated surfaces.
- · Connect this appliance only to a properly grounded outlet.
- To avoid injury, exercise care when entering or exiting the chair and foot bath.
- Use caution when making positioning adjustments to your chair. Keep all equipment and body parts away from moving parts while making any adjustments.
- It is important that you clean and disinfect the jet and basin after every use.
- Hydrotherapy should be pleasant and comfortable. Should you or a client experience any pain or discomfort while using the foot bath, discontinue use immediately and consult a physician.
- You or your clients should consult a physician if diabetic, have poor circulation, if feet or legs are inflamed, have an open wound, or if you have questions about whether you should be using hydro massage equipment.
- A qualified plumber and electrician are strongly recommended to install your foot bath.
- Make certain that the cord and plug are maintained in good condition and are not allowed to become damaged while in use. Avoid positioning the cord in the traffic lane and it is always kept out of the way. Take this furnishing out of service immediately if the cord or plug becomes damaged in any way.
- Do not attempt to repair. All repairs must be performed by an authorized service representative.
- Chair and tub are to remain right side up. At no time should chair or tub be turned on it's side or upside
- down.




INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS / GROUNDING INSTRUCTIONS

1. RISK OF ELECTRIC SHOCK. Connect only to a circuit protected by a ground-fault circuit-interrupter.

2. Grounding is required. The unit should be installed by a qualified service representative and grounded.


This product must be grounded. If it should malfunction or break down, grounding provides a path of least resistance for electric current to reduce the risk of electric shock. This product is equipped with a cord having an equipment-grounding conductor and grounding plug. The plug must be plugged into an appropriate outlet that is properly installed and grounded in accordance with all local codes and ordinances.

Improper connection of the equipment-grounding connector can result in a risk of electric shock. Check with a qualified electrician or serviceman if you are in doubt as to whether the product is properly grounded. 

Retractable Tub Operation

Your Club LE has a tub that conveniently retracts underneath the chair for manicure positioning.



Always use extreme caution when making any position adjustments to your chair/tub. Ensure all body parts and objects are clear from all moving parts. DO NOT retract tub when water is in the basin.



Power Back Tilt Operation

Your chair is equipped with a power recline button located on the inside of the right arm of the chair. See below for instructions on how to operate.




Water Fill Valve

The water fill valve is OFF when pointing DOWN. Water dispenses when you pull the valve UP. For hot water, turn valve to the RIGHT. For cold water, turn valve to the LEFT.



There is no automatic shutoff with the water fill valve. You MUST turn the valve OFF after the tub is filled to prevent overflow and/or flooding. Do not walk away from the tub when it is filling with water.



Pipeless Jet & Chromasoothe Light

Pressing the respective On/Off button once will turn on the jet or light, and pressing the button again will turn it off. Turn on the jet ONLY AFTER the tub is filled with water, and ensure you turn the jet OFF before draining the tub.



Running the jet without filling the tub with water can damage or destroy the jet. Ensure that a MINIMUM of one (1) inch of water is above the jet prior to use.



Drain Release & Discharge Pump Operation

- Turn the drain knob clockwise to close the drain when filling the tub.
- Turn the knob counterclockwise to open the drain and empty the tub.
- Discharge pump button is location directly below the jet/light button. Before pressing the button, open the drain with the drain knob and let the water start draining towards the pump. Wait approximately 5-10 seconds for the pump to register, then push the discharge pump button.




Footrest Operation



Always use extreme caution when making any position adjustments to your footrest. Ensure all body parts and objects are clear from all moving parts.

CAUTION

Do not sit on or put full body weight on the footrest. It is meant only to support a client's feet for a pedicure, not to support body weight.

Swingaway Manicure Trays (Optional)

The Swingaway Manicure Trays are a convenient way to offer manicure services in your pedicure chair. See below on how to install and store your trays.

To Set Up:

Insert the tray post into the receiver and push straight down to secure.



To Remove: Lift tray evenly with one hand placed on either side of the receiver. Tray may get stuck if only lifted from one side.

To Store:


Insert the tray post into the storage receiver, and push all the way in to prevent the tray from falling out.



Tray Positioning

The manicure trays can easily be swiveled to any position that is desired. Below are the most commonly used tray positions and their functions.

Position 1: Places trays closer to the client and allows the magnetic center tray to be attached.Position 2: Places trays closer to the technician and provides more room for the client.Position 3: Allows the trays to function as extended armrests or table.




Magnetic Center Tray (Optional)

The Magnetic Center Tray provides even more surface area for your manicure services. Place the center tray on the Swingaway Manicure Trays, and move it slightly back and forth until the magnets "catch". The finished configuration will look like the photo below:

Cleaning & Ongoing Maintenance

The following procedures are important guidelines that will help in keep your Club LE clean and trouble free for years. It is extremely important to clean and disinfect each and every pedicure chair after each pedicure and after the last pedicure of the day. (See next page for instructions.)

YOU ARE REQUIRED TO CHECK WITH YOUR STATE BOARD FOR MANDATORY CLEANING AND DISINFECTING REQUIREMENTS AND PROCEDURES.



DO NOT USE acetone, paint thinner, "Armor All" type cleaners, or industrial cleaners for ANY part of your chair, tub, or components.

DO NOT place nail care products on the tub.

Extended exposure to harsh chemicals can damage the basin, footpad, and/or upholstery. Failure to comply with all cleaning instructions can cause damage and void your warranty.

Category	Care Recommendation
Upholstery	Remove day-to-day dirt and smudges with a mild soap and water solution. For tough stains and to disinfect, use a (100 to 1) water to bleach solution. Spray a damp cloth with the solution to clean. After each cleaning, gently wipe the upholstery with a damp cloth and clean water, then allow upholstery to air dry before using or storing. For more difficult stains, please contact your dealer or please call us directly
	for guidance. For best results, use only the products suggested above.
Laminate	Never use abrasive cleaners. A mild liquid detergent and warm water will clean soiled surfaces. To avoid discoloration, cleaners containing petroleum distillates must not remain on surfaces.
Basin-Acrylic/ Capped/ Fiberglass	Do NOT use abrasive pads or cleaners on any surface. Wipe clean with a sponge or soft brush. Follow State's cleaning and disinfecting procedures.
Stubborn Dirt, Stains, or surface imperfections	Occasionally stains will not be removed by the above steps, in this case the use of a Mr. Clean® Magic Eraser will allow for a more aggressive cleaning without damaging the surface finish. Use the Magic Eraser following the directions on the package.
Footrest	A mild detergent and warm water is all that is needed to clean the padded footrest. However care should be taken to prevent nail polish or acetone from coming in contact with the footrest. These products may damage or discolor the upholstery. In spite of taking necessary precautions to protect the leg supports, hard water and/or certain products many cause the black footrests to develop a white film or some discoloration. If this occurs, use a product called "Black Max"- Vinyl and Rubber Dressing.

SECTION 4: CARE & MAINTENANCE

Tub Cleaning Guide



Always refer to your state and local codes for specific cleaning requirements. NEVER USE abrasive cleaners on any surface area. Failure to comply can cause damage and void your warranty.

The removable jet assembly MUST be placed into the motor housing in the correct order and position or the jet may be damaged. This will NOT be covered by any Living Earth Crafts warranty. Never turn the jet on without adequate water in the basin. There must be at least one (1) inch of water above the motor housing.

Recommended Cleaning and Disinfecting Products

Your state board requires disinfecting of your pedicure basin. Living Earth Crafts recommends "Splish Splash One-Step Disinfectant."

While other EPA registered products are available for maintaining pedicure tubs, we have found Splish Splash to be the most effective, multi-purpose and economical product on the market.

Products NOT Recommended

- Silicate based bath additives/scrubs may void warranty.
- Oil-based products.
- High foam agents (use only low foam solutions).
- Abrasive cleaners that might damage the system components, and scratch/dull the basin surface (major scratches will require professional refinishing.
- To avoid discoloration, products with petroleum distillates must not remain on surfaces.

Tub Liners

Tub liners may be used with this system - it must sit between the housing and the impeller.

Tub Cleaning Guide

Cleaning After Each Client & End of Day

- 1. Drain the tub of all water.
- 2. Firmly pull the jet assembly away from the tub to remove. (Fig. 1)
- 3. Rotate the cover to unlock and separate the cover, magnetic impeller, and housing. (See Fig. 2 to show how to unlock, See previous page for image identifying jet assembly parts.)
- 4. Place jet cover, impeller, and housing into a sink. Use a non-abrasive liquid soap and a clean brush to remove any visible residue. Rinse with fresh water, and dry with a clean paper towel.
- 5. Reassemble the jet assembly and reattach to the tub.
- 6. Fill basin with warm water and add the correct amount of an EPA-registered liquid disinfectant (Splish Splash strongly recommended). Turn on the jet to circulate the water for at least 10 minutes, scrubbing all visible residue from the inside walls of the basin with a sponge/soft brush. NOTE: Brushes must be cleaned/disinfected after each use.
- 7. Drain the basin, rinse with fresh water, and wipe dry with a clean paper towel.





Cleaning Every Other Week

- 1. Fill tub with water and one-third (1/3) cup of 5.25% chlorine bleach for each one (1) gallon of water. (An alternative to bleach would be an EPA-registered disinfectant with demonstrated bactericidal, fungicidal, and virucidal activity.)
- 2. Turn on the jets to circulate the solution for 5-10 minutes and then sit for 6-10 hours.
- 3. Drain the basin, rinse well with fresh water, and wipe dry with a clean paper towel.

Troubleshooting

This helpful troubleshooting guide will provide you with information about how to recognize a problem with your product, determine possible causes, and find a solution.

In the event your specific situation is not covered in this guide, please contact Living Earth Crafts so our technical support department can assist you. Beyond the troubleshooting guide below, do not attempt to repair the issue yourself. This can void your warranty.

Issue	Solution
No Power/Not Operating	 Ensure the power cord is properly plugged into an operational GFCI power supply/outlet. Check GFCI reset and circuit breakers or fuses. Ensure the outlet in your room is receiving power. This can be done by plugging in a small appliance and turning it on.
No Power to Jet/ Jet not Operating	 Ensure the power cord is properly plugged into an operational GFCI power supply/outlet. Check GFCI reset and circuit breakers or fuses. Ensure magnetic rotor/impeller is correctly installed in the case. Reset the motors by unplugging the system, waiting 5 seconds, then plugging in again.
Excessive Noise from Jet	 Remove jet assembly and inspect for dirt buildup, debris, wear, or damage. Follow cleaning instructions or replace if necessary.
Water Leakage	 Check and ensure all visible bolts are tightened. Call a plumber to determine the source of the leak. If the leak is from the jet system, contact LEC customer service.

Warranty Information

Living Earth Crafts (LEC) offers an industry best warranty on all pedicure units.

- Motors and controls, actuators, foam and upholstery are warranted for two
 (2) years, including parts and labor unless otherwise noted.
- Glass parts are warranted for one (1) year.
- Accessories and replacement parts are warranted for ninety (90) days from date of shipment.

Living Earth Crafts may repair or replace defective components at our discretion. Living Earth Crafts will return the warranted product, standard shipping pre- paid, to customers in the continental US. International customers are responsible for any applicable duties and taxes, as well as all shipping charges inbound and outbound.

Excluded from Limited Warranty:

- 1. Unauthorized repairs.
- 2. Damage due to freight, accident, natural disaster, and/or abuse.
- Damage or malfunctions due to improper installation including but not limited to, failure to comply with all national, state, and local plumbing, electrical, and building codes.
- 4. Fading, discoloration, or staining of any part due to improper water additives, hard water, or harmful cleaning agents or chemicals.
- 5. Damage to drain pump due to obstruction in drain hose and/or debris in pump impeller housing.

- Black plastic parts

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- Any LED light
- Handheld control wands
- Any international shipment including but not limited to Canada and Mexico

All warranties are limited to repair or replacement, at Living Earth Craft's discretion, unless otherwise stated. This limited warranty applies only to pedicure chairs installed in any one of the fifty (50) States of the United States, the District of Columbia, or provinces of Canada.






Backflow Prevention (Discharge Line)

Each Contour comes with a swing check valve pre-installed on the discharge line. This valve is NSF certified for potatable water use (see detailed specification from manufacturer on the next page). The valve is installed on the discharge line immediately after the discharge pump as shown in the technical diagram below. The placement prevents backflow from the discharge line into the tub.
