SECTION 1: SAFETY INFORMATION

- e) Physical inability to exit the hydromassage bathtub, and

- Keep the electrical cord away from heated surfaces.
- Connect this appliance only to a properly grounded outlet.
- To avoid injury, exercise care when entering or exiting the chair and foot bath.
- Use caution when making positioning adjustments to your chair. Keep all equipment and body parts away from moving parts while making any adjustments.
- It is important that you clean and disinfect the bowl after every use.
- Should you or a client experience any pain or discomfort while using the foot bath, discontinue use immediately and consult a physician.
- You or your clients should consult a physician if diabetic, have poor circulation, if feet or legs are inflamed, have an open wound, or if you have questions about whether you should be using a foot bath.
- Make certain that the cord and plug are maintained in good condition and are not allowed to become
 damaged while in use. Avoid positioning the cord in the traffic lane and it is always kept out of the
 way. Take this furnishing out of service immediately if the cord or plug becomes damaged in any way.
- Do not attempt to repair. All repairs must be performed by an authorized service representative.
- Chair and tub are to remain right side up. At no time should chair or tub be turned on it's side or upside down.

SECTION 3: OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Footrest Operation



Always use extreme caution when making any position adjustments to your footrest. Ensure all body parts and objects are clear from all moving parts.



Do not sit on or put full body weight on the footrest. It is meant only to support a client's feet for a pedicure, not to support body weight.



Footrest Height Knob

Supporting footrest with one hand, pull the knob to unlock and adjust the height. Release knob to lock footrest into place.

Retractable Bowl Operation

Your Wilshire M has a bowl that conveniently retracts underneath the chair for manicure positioning. A cover is included that can be placed over the bowl once fully retracted.



Always use extreme caution when making any position adjustments to your chair/bowl. Ensure all body parts and objects are clear from all moving parts.



Bowl Pull Knob

Use this knob to push/pull the bowl to the desired position.


Relaxor® Heat & Massage (Optional)

RISK OF ELECTRIC SHOCK

Keep hand control and all electrical components away from water.

Cleaning & Ongoing Maintenance

The following procedures are important guidelines that will help in keep your Wilshire M clean and trouble free for years. It is extremely important to clean and disinfect each pedicure chair after each pedicure and after the last pedicure of the day. (See next page for instructions.)

YOU ARE REQUIRED TO CHECK WITH YOUR STATE BOARD FOR MANDATORY CLEANING AND DISINFECTING REQUIREMENTS AND PROCEDURES.



DO NOT USE acetone, paint thinner, bleach, "Armor All" type cleaners, or industrial cleaners for ANY part of your chair, bowl, or components.

DO NOT place nail care products on edge of the bowl.

Extended exposure to chemicals like bleach can damage the bowl, footpad, and/or upholstery. Failure to comply with all cleaning instructions can cause damage and void your warranty.

Category	Care Recommendation
Upholstery	See next page
Laminate	Never use abrasive cleaners. A mild liquid detergent and warm water will clean soiled surfaces. To avoid discoloration, cleaners containing petroleum distillates must not remain on surfaces.
	CAUTION: Always refer to your state and local codes for specific cleaning requirements. NEVER USE abrasive cleaners on any surface area. Failure to comply can cause damage and void your warranty.
Copper Bowl	We recommend using a mild bleach solution (1 part bleach to 3 parts water) or "Splish Splash One-Step Disinfectant" to clean your copper pedicure bowl. Use a dry, clean cloth to remove all water drops.
	DO NOT USE metal scrubbers to avoid any plating damage, silicate based bath additives/scrubs, oil-based products. abrasive cleaners, and products with petroleum distillates.
Footrest	A mild detergent and warm water is all that is needed to clean the padded footrest. However care should be taken to prevent nail polish or acetone from coming in contact with the footrest. These products may damage or discolor the upholstery. In spite of taking necessary precautions to protect the leg supports, hard water and/or certain products many cause the black footrests to develop a white film or some discoloration. If this occurs, use a product called "Black Max"- Vinyl and Rubber Dressing.

Upholstery Cleaning & Maintenance

Follow the below cleaning instructions for your chair's upholstery. NOTE: There are different instructions for Nature's Touch upholstery vs. Urban Velvet and Urban Weave. Ensure you follow the correct procedures.

Nature's Touch Upholstery

Remove day-to-day dirt and smudges with a mild soap and water solution. For tough stains and to disinfect, use a (100 to 1) water to bleach solution. Spray a damp cloth with the solution to clean.

After each cleaning, gently wipe the upholstery with a damp cloth and clean water, then allow upholstery to air dry before using or storing.

For more difficult stains, please contact your dealer or please call us directly for guidance. For best results, use only the products suggested above.

Urban Velvet & Urban Weave Upholstery

1. Clean liquid spills quickly with a dry, clean, absorbent cloth. For liquids still beading up:

- Gently blot (don't rub) a spill immediately with a dry, clean, absorbent cloth
- No rinsing needed!

2. If any residual spot remains, rinse freely with warm water:

- Remove any excess soil or debris from the surface. Flush soiled area liberally with warm water then blot with a dry, clean, absorbent cloth.
- Change towel surface frequently until spot is gone. Try to avoid brushing which can spread the stain; keep repeating the process until the spot has been removed.
- Repeat again by rinsing with warm water and then blot clean, dry cloth if needed.
- It is ok to use a water extraction machine if desired (follow directions on machine).

3. For difficult or stubborn stains:

- Follow steps 1 & 2 first...then using 2-3 drops of a mild dishwasher detergent with a cup of water - apply to the soiled area.
- Gently work the solution into the area, wait a minute and blot the spot with a clean, dry, absorbent cloth. Repeat until spot has been completely removed.
- After cleaning, be sure to rinse thoroughly with warm water and blot to remove any soap residue.
- Any remaining soap not rinsed away in the fabric can cause a reoccurring stain.
- For more difficult stains, please contact your dealer or please call us directly for guidance.

4. DO NOT USE:

- Harsh detergents or solvents
- Fabric softeners
- Cleaners containing oxidizers

SECTION 4: CARE & MAINTENANCE

Warranty Information

Living Earth Crafts (LEC) offers an industry best warranty on all pedicure units.

- Motors and controls, actuators, foam and upholstery are warranted for two
 (2) years, including parts and labor unless otherwise noted.
- Glass parts are warranted for one (1) year.
- Accessories and replacement parts are warranted for ninety (90) days from date of shipment.

Living Earth Crafts may repair or replace defective components at our discretion. Living Earth Crafts will return the warranted product, standard shipping pre-paid, to customers in the continental US. International customers are responsible for any applicable duties and taxes, as well as all shipping charges inbound and outbound.

Excluded from Limited Warranty:

- 1. Unauthorized repairs.
- 2. Damage due to freight, accident, natural disaster, and/or abuse.
- Damage or malfunctions due to improper installation including but not limited to, failure to comply with all national, state, and local plumbing, electrical, and building codes.
- 4. Fading, discoloration, or staining of any part due to improper water additives, hard water, or harmful cleaning agents or chemicals.
- 5. Damage to drain pump due to obstruction in drain hose and/or debris in pump impeller housing.

Parts and/or circumstances for which labor is NOT COVERED - Parts noted below are simple to replace and DO NOT require a service technician:

- Jet cover and/or impeller
- Footrest/leg supports
- On/off air actuated button
- Black plastic parts
- Manicure trays
- Replacement upholstery
- Faucet cartridge and/or filler-sprayer
- Relaxor
- Any LED light
- Handheld control wands
- Any international shipment including but not limited to Canada and Mexico





Technical Drawings





Plumbing & Power Connections - Required Setup



2½" External Vent Pipe Wall Mount male stub Flex or Hard Mount IMPORTANT: Client's ventilation intake needs to pull a minimum of 165 CFM at the chair's connection point to achieve 50 CFM at all chair's intakes.
