please check contents against the components list in these instructions. also, please ensure there was no damage that may have occurred in shipping.

if any components are missing or you find any damage, please contact ducduc before continuing.

read all the instructions before use. pay close attention to the safety warnings in these instructions.

a minimum of two people is required to safely assemble and move the bookcase. do not attempt to move this bookcase alone — dragging or sliding it across a floor may cause structural damage.

MAINTENANCE:

please remember to securely tighten all bolts and fasteners, and periodically check to make sure every component is properly and securely in place and all bolts and fasteners are tight.

CLEANING:

do not scratch or chip the finish. do not use abrasive chemicals for cleaning, clean with mild soap on a soft rag, rinse and dry thoroughly, if you ever refinish this furniture, be sure to use only a non-toxic finish specified for children's furniture.


household hammer or rubber mallet


a soft surface to assemble on (like a rug or some of the corrugate box your piece arrived in)

(unless you're a cat person)


before you begin!

grab your household hammer and locate the parts listed below.




then, follow the instructions below. once completed and all dowel pins are secured, move on to step 1!


- line up the skinny end of the green dowel pins (M2) with the holes located on the top edges of the L side panel and R side panel (parts: A1 and A2)
- apply hammer cap (K) to the head of a household hammer and hit the top of the dowel until it is fully secure.




- line up the end of the green cinch pins (M1) with the holes located on the back edges of the L side panel and R side panel. (parts: A1 and A2)
- apply hammer with cap (K) and hit the top of the dowel until it is fully secure
- repeat on back edge of sides until all holes are filled



lean R side panel (A1) against a wall with the holes facing away from wall and connectors facing upward as shown.




insert connectors of bottom panel (C) and fixed shelf (D) into slots on R side panel (A1) and push down at the connection to lock into place.



insert remaining connectors of bottom panel (C) and fixed shelf (D) into slots on L side panel (A2), and push down at the connection to lock into place.





line up the connectors on both sides (A1+A2) with the holes on the underside of top (E). use hammer with hammer cap (K) to tap top (E) until there is no gap at the connection to the sides (A1+A2).






using the provided feet (G) with attached hanger bolts (H), attach the feet (G+H) to bottom (C) with t-nut (I).










now we build the drawer! starting with drawer face (DBI) facing down, insert connectors of both drawer box side panels (DB3+DB4) into slots on drawer face (DBI). push down at the connections to lock into place.







rotate the partially assembled drawer box as shown. slide drawer box bottom (DB5) into place using grooves on the drawer box side panels (DB3 + DB4) as guides. be sure glide hardware on bottom panel (DB5) is positioned outside the drawer interior and toward the drawer face (DB1) as shown.








again, rotate partially assembled drawer box as shown. insert connectors of drawer box back (DB2) into slots on drawer box sides (DB3 + DB4). push down at the connections to lock into place. use hammer and hammer cap (K) if needed.











Stand the bookcase up and pull the drawer glides out to extended position as shown.







place the assembled drawer box onto extended glides as shown. from underside of drawer, use hands to pull each glide forward until it locks into connection with glide hardware attached to drawer box bottom (DB5). the drawer will be secure when you hear a click on each connection. once secured, push drawer box in to close.


insert 8 shelf pins (J) into holes on both sides (A1 + A2) at desired heights.






one at a time, place adjustable shelf (F) on top of 4 shelf pins (J) so it sits secure and level.





10 safety strap installation




the last step for your tall bookcase is to install the safety strap included in the box. reference the separate instructions enclosed in the envelope.
