

MAINTENANCE:


please remember to securely tighten all bolts and fasteners, and periodically check to make sure every component is properly and securely in place and all bolts and fasteners are tight.

CLEANING:

do not scratch or chip the finish. do not use abrasive chemicals for cleaning. clean with mild soap on a soft rag. rinse and dry thoroughly. if you ever refinish this furniture, be sure to use only a non-toxic finish specified for children's furniture.






knox pull hardware

I (x2) screw for knox pull

L (x8) JCB bolt (20mm)






a soft surface to assemble on (like a rug or some of the corrugate box your piece arrived in)






beginning in one corner, take one foot (G) as seen below, and insert the bolt located on foot (G) into the brackets on bottom panel (C). Twist until the foot is fully secure, and repeat for all feet (G) provided. Place bottom panel with attached feet aside for now.







insert connectors on back panel (B) into slots on R side panel (A1). push down at the connection to lock into place. if needed, use hammer with hammer cap (J) to tap until secure.



insert connectors on back panel (B) into slots on remaining L side panel (A2). push down or tap with hammer + hammer cap (J) at the connection to lock into place.











locate bottom panel (C) with attached feet (H) before moving on to the next step.



insert connectors on both side panels (A1 + A2) into slots on bottom panel (C). push down or tap with hammer and hammer cap (J) to lock into place.




lower both center partitions (E) into the partially assembled case. insert connectors on center partitions (E) into the remaining slots on bottom panel (C). push down or tap with hammer and hammer cap (J) to lock into place.




flip partially assembled case into upright position. line up holes of top (D) with the connectors of side panels (A1 + A2), center partitions (E) and back panel (B). tap with hammer and hammer cap (J) to lock into place.




using a phillips screwdriver and screw (I), attach the pull hardware (H) to the door panel (F).



repeat step 12 for remaining door (F).




slightly angle one door panel (F) into the case as shown below. Insert the door upward into the track closest to the back of the case. then, allow the door to drop down into the same track on the bottom panel (C). to confirm that it is installed correctly, just try sliding the door side to side.


slightly angle the remaining door panel (F) into the case as shown below. Insert the door upward into the track closest to the front of the case, then, allow the door to drop down into the same track on the bottom panel (C), to confirm that it is installed correctly, just try sliding the door side to side.






before you move on!


the following instructions describe how to stack your toy storage units and apply the safety strap if stacking two or more. if you will not be stacking your toy storage units, you can stop here. in order to stack these storage units, you'll need to remove the leg brackets on the underside of bottom panel (C). using your philips head screw driver, remove all leg brackets.




now that your leg brackets have been removed, repeat steps 3-13 to build your remaining storage units that you'd like to stack.



place your first toy storage unit (with legs attached) in the area it will stay. do not try to move the unit once it has been stacked. then, have a friend help you lift the second toy storage unit on top of the first. be sure all corners are aligned before moving forward.



starting at one side, place square bracket (K) over the holes on the back of each storage unit. secure into place using the allen key (O) to screw in hardware (M+ N + L) as arranged in the picture, then, repeat on the remaining side.




duc insider tip!

start by loosely screwing in each bolt over the bracket. once everything is lined up and each of the 4 bolts are in place, fully tighten all screws until secure.


repeat on the remaining bracket using the same method.

repeat step 19 if you have a remaining toy storage unit that you would like to stack. please note: we only recommend stacking 3 units at once.



19 safety strap installation


the last step for your stacking toy storage is to install the safety strap included in the box. reference the separate instructions enclosed in the envelope.
