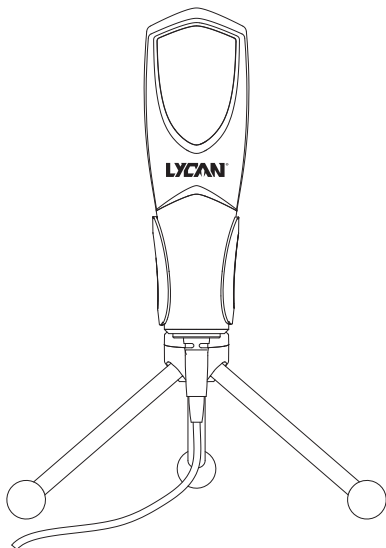

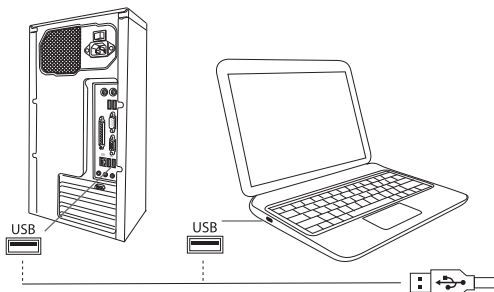
HOW TO SET UP MICROPHONE

- ① Unfold the legs on the stand and place on desktop.
- ② Slide microphone into stand holder until it feels secure.
- ③ Plug XLR into base of microphone.

Foldable tripod stand



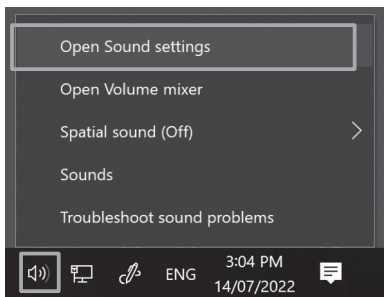
- ④ Connect USB plug of microphone to USB port on your desktop computer or laptop.



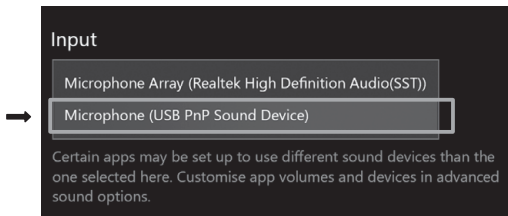
WINDOWS 10 SETTINGS FOR USB MICROPHONE

Connect USB plug of microphone to USB port on your desktop computer or laptop. The microphone should connect automatically and be ready to use. If it does not connect automatically, please follow the following instructions:

- ① Right-click the Audio Manager icon on the lower right of the desktop, then click Open Sound settings.

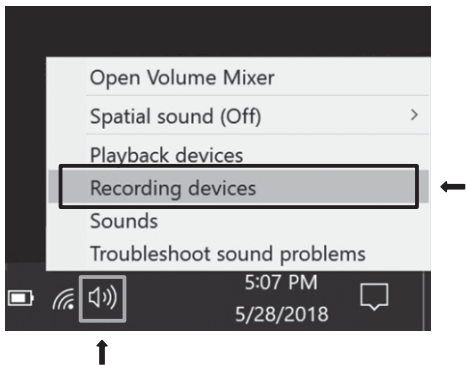


- ② Select Microphone (USB PnP Sound Device) from the drop-down menu.

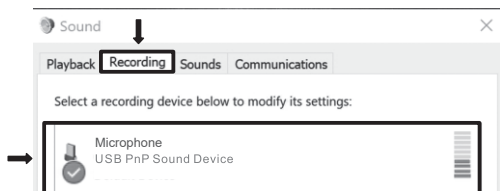


WINDOWS 7/8 SETTINGS FOR USB MICROPHONE

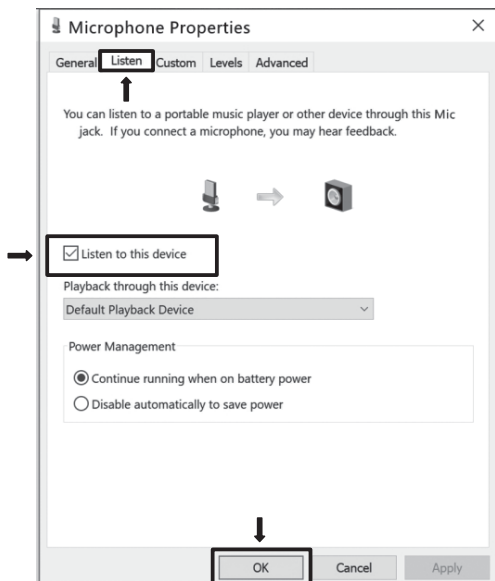
- ① Connect USB plug of microphone to USB port on your desktop computer or laptop.
- ② Right-click the Audio Manager icon on the lower right of the desktop, then click recording devices.



- ③ You can see the microphone is set up and is on default. Double-click on Microphone to view Microphone properties.

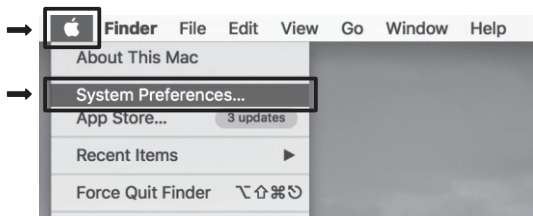


- ④ Go to Listen and tick listen to this device, then click the OK button (If you need to monitor when recording, click OK to save the settings).
- ⑤ Now click on OK to save the settings.



macOS SETTINGS FOR USB MICROPHONE

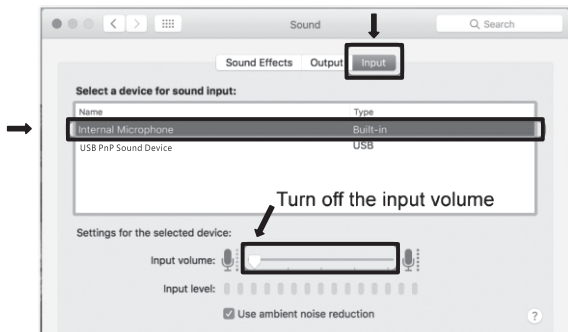
- 1 Click the desktop menu, then click System Preferences.



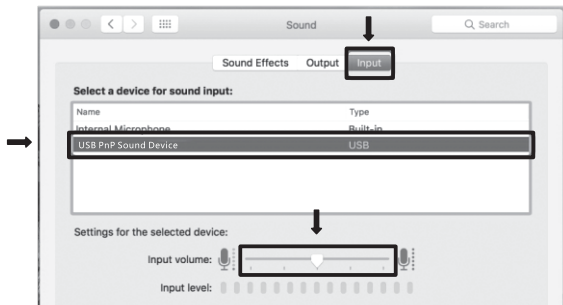
- 2 Find sound button and click it.



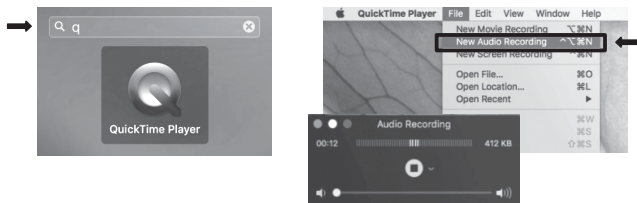
- 3 Choose input and select 'Internal Microphone' and turn off the input volume.



- ④ Choose USB Microphone 'USB PnP Sound Device' and adjust input volume. (General adjustment is in the middle).



- ⑤ To test the microphone sound, search the built-in software: QuickTime Player.
⑥ Right click and select 'New Audio Recording'.
⑦ After selecting the external USB microphone, click the record button and recording will begin.
