


# 7-IN-1 FOLDABLE LIGHT REFLECTOR



Welcome to the #influencer 7-in-1 Foldable Light Reflector. Here are the instructions on how to use so you can get on with creating content.

### **SPECIFICATIONS**

Size: 90cm x 120cm

Material: 100% Polyester Taffeta

1 x Blue / green

1 x Black / gold

1 x Silver / white


1 x Opaque

## **USAGE INSTRUCTIONS:**


- 1. Review the current lighting situation and what effect you would like to achieve.
- 2. Select the reflector colour / opaque to use.
- 3. If using a colour other than opaque, use the zips to attach the colour onto the opaque layer, so that the loop at top is showing.
- 4. The loop can be attached to the top of a tripod, or if someone can assist by holding in the right place.
- **Black** use to absorb light reflections when you have too much light shining on an object, or is used to create shadows for effect.
- **Green** used to make consistent background colour so that effects can be applied in production / streaming.
- **Blue** similar to green, but used when person / object has green on it and editing the background is harder.
- Gold is great for outdoor portraits as it matches the warm colour tones of sunlight. Works best when reflecting sunlight and casting a warm glow on the subject. Caution to not overdo the amount of light as can turn skin tones yellow. Gold is not recommended for studio or flash work.
- White is used to create highlights of lighting on a subject the light reflected is close to natural light, and is best used in either a studio or outside, when there is ample light as it won't affect colours of subject. Not very effective in low-light situations and you may need to get closer to subject to see effect.
- **Silver** reflects the most light and can be used further away from the subject than others, but can also create too much light, placement needs to be correct to get the desired effect.
- Opaque (Translucent) is used to soften light and create nice soft shadows / highlights. Use in front of flash or between the sun and subject.

  Can also be used as a background for portrait photography.

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR FOLDING AWAY:



**1** Fold the top and bottom of the backdrop together and center the velcro loop on top.



2 Rest the frame on your legs and hold the outer corners. Pull right the outer corner in towards the center.



**3** Pull the left corner in and over the right corner.



**4** Pull the folded corners toward you and push the back down into alignment.



**5** Lightly shake to event the fold before storing it into the storage bag.
