These include, among others: ☐ Vacuuming or mopping smooth floors ☐ Vacuuming carpets and, if necessary, removing stains ☐ Wiping down desks and other tables Cleaning and disinfecting high-touch surfaces (light switches, door handles, etc.). ☐ Dusting cupboards, shelves and window sills Cleaning and sorting dishes in kitchens and staff rooms ☐ Wiping work surfaces and counters with a damp cloth Thoroughly cleaning and disinfecting toilets, urinals and sinks in washrooms ☐ Wiping sanitary surfaces with a damp cloth Cleaning fixtures ☐ Changing towels Refilling hygienic products such as toilet paper ☐ Emptying trash cans
