- · Remove and properly dispose of used batteries.


Please pay attention to these instructions before using for the first time

Opening the Safety Device at the First Time


 Please remove the keyhole cover on the panel, insert the key and turn it counterclockwise, and meanwhile turn the handle to right way to open the door

Battery Installation



- A. Remove the battery compartment cap, place 4AA batteries(included) in the compartment.
 - Please pay attention to the "+" and "-" signs.
- B.To install the batteries, locate the battery compartment.
 - Place the batteries into the compartment.

WRANING

Please pay attention to battery usage, maintenance and disposal information Repeat above steps for battery replacement.

I Operation

Change Password

When you first time use it you should change the default code as soon as possible to prevent unauthorized access to your safe, so it should be kept confidential.

A. Username password setting:

- 1. Press the Reset Button followed by two beeps of "DiDi", the yellow light goes on.
- 2. Enter your New code with any 1-8 digits and press "LOCK" to confirm.
- 3. The yellow light goes out with two beeps, indicating the password has been set successfully.
- 4. Now test the code. If you make a mistake and the new code will not work(five beeps with the yellow light goes on if the incorrect entry is made), simply start over with step 1.

B. Manager password setting:

- 1. Input "0" twice, and then press the Reset Button followed by two beeps of "DiDi", the yellow light goes on.
- 2. Enter your New code with any 1-8 digits and press "LOCK" to confirm.
- 3. The yellow light goes out with two beeps, indicating the password has been set successfully.
- 4. Now test the code. If you make a mistake and the new code will not work(five beeps with the yellow light goes on if the incorrect entry is made), simply start over with step 1.

I Operation

Opening the Safe

- 1. Input the set username password or manager password.
- 2. Press the confirming button "LOCK" with two beeps of "DiDi" and the green light goes on, indicating the password is correct. Then make the handle to right way and open the door(the opening action must be completed within 5 seconds).
- 3. If the password is wrong, then five beeps with the yellow light goes on.
- 4. If the wrong password input three times in a row, the alarm will ring for 60s. Only input the correct password will clear the alarm.

More Functions

Alarm Setting:

 Press "LOCK" to enter the alert state automatically. When the safe is vibrated, the alarm will sound. Input correct password to cancel the alarm. If input the incorrect code, the alarm will stop after 60 seconds.

Low Battery Warning:

• If the red light is on when press the code by electronic way, your battery level is critically low and your safe needs to be replaced the 4 new batteries.

To Close and Lock:

· Turn the handle return to close the door.
