

Quick & Easy Paper Purses

Instructions:

1. Select the purse(s) you want to make and print on heavy white paper.

TIP: If you don't have heavy paper, use regular printer paper.

2. Cut out the purse and pieces for the bow.

3. Fold on the fold lines.

4. Glue the tabs onto the inside of the purse. The cut out 'V' shapes will allow you to glue the tab in a curved shape like the side of the purse.

5. Make the Bow: Glue the ends of the Bow Loops piece together. Pinch together in the very middle and glue together.

6. Glue the Bow Center Wrap around the middle of the bow.

7. Glue the whole thing onto the center of Bow Ribbon Ends piece.

8. Glue onto your purse.

Add other decorations if you like: buttons, ribbons, paper flowers, jewels, glitter, etc.

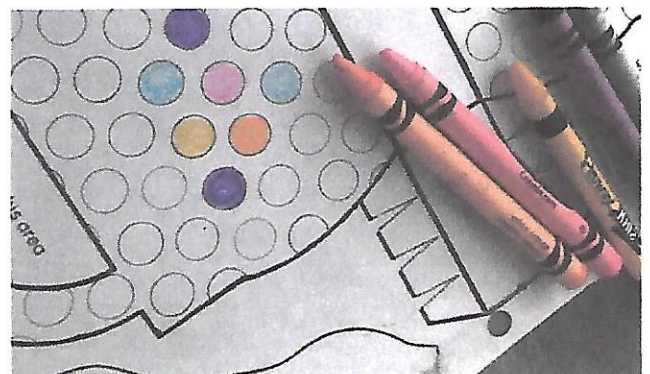


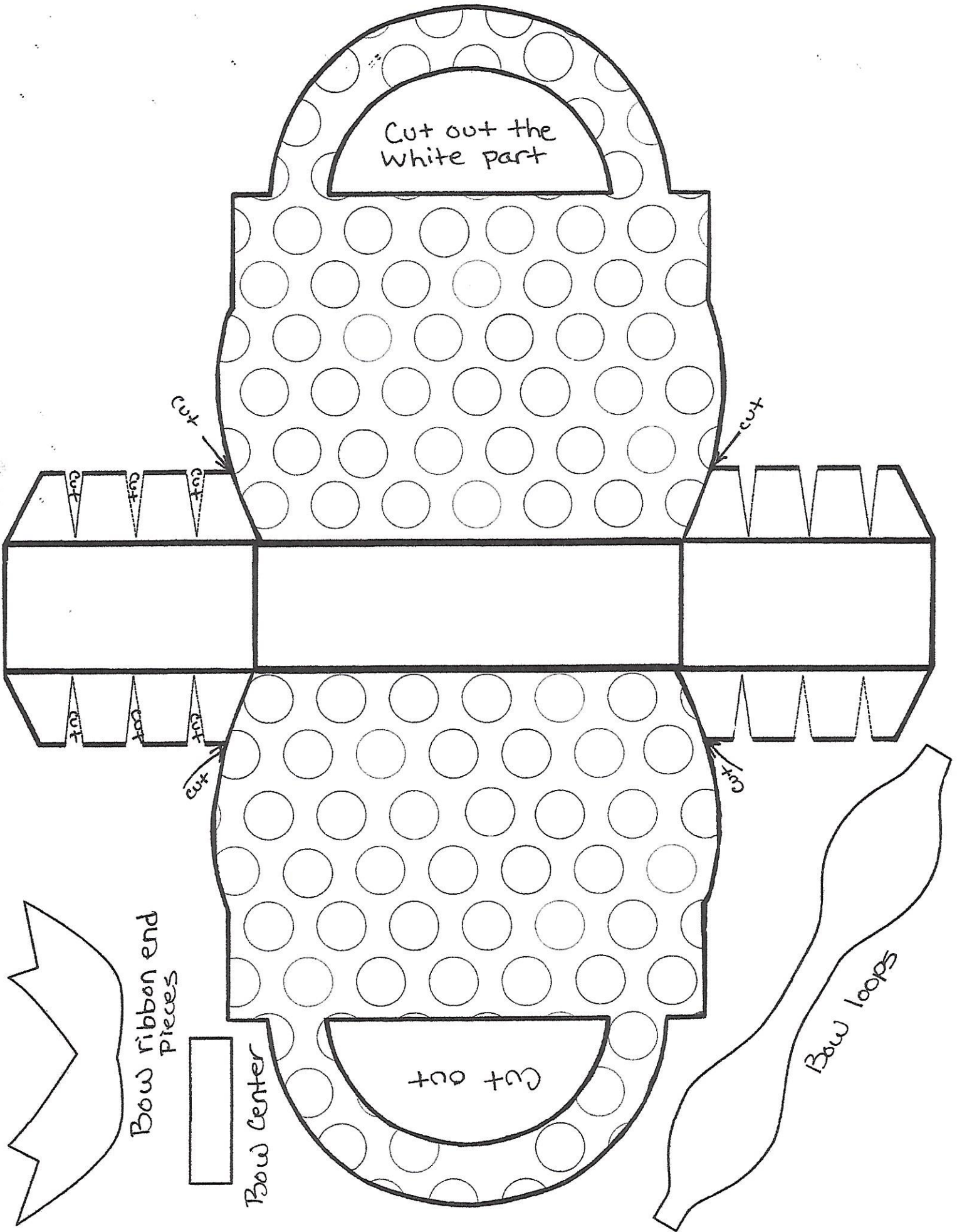
These cute paper purses make fun gifts! Fill with notes, jokes, drawings, or a special treat or other little surprise for someone special.

Materials & Supplies

- Computer and Printer
- Heavy white paper to print on OR regular printer paper and cereal box or similar to glue the page(s) onto
- Scissors
- Glue
- Optional: Stick-on jewels, ribbons, buttons, glitter, etc.

Note: If you don't have color ink, just print the black & white page and color it yourself with markers, crayons, or colored pencils.
