



What strikes me the most about HADO is that it's not all about entertainment. Depending on what you want to teach—technology, teamwork or communication skills—you can tailor the teaching approach to reach your objective, and so it's quite easy to introduce it as an educational tool.

On a 6x10m court, in a natural way, students communicate, cheer on each other, and play hard. After the end of match, teams gather to discuss for a better strategy. As an audience, they shout, jump up and down, and cheer for classmates. HADO is a team sport that combines AR technology through a head-mounted display and arm sensor on a real-world court where players can freely run to compete. Three-player teams leverage their skills by firing energy balls and placing shields to accumulate points in an 80-second match. The intuitive and easy operability as well as simple rules make it easy for anyone to enjoy the sport.

The uniqueness of the sport is that anyone throughout all generations can enjoy regardless of physical ability.



Before the match, players can allocate ten points across four different parameters in an effort to tailor the game to their strengths and weaknesses. With competitions and tournaments held globally, HADO has accelerated its advancement as a competitive and strategic sport that has never been seen before.
