Critical Thinking

Social Awareness

Creating an environment where all players are encouraged to input their perspectives to successfully complete challenges.

Self Awareness

Allowing students to form ideas, acknowledge them, and share them with others as potential solutions.

Relationship Skills

Creating relationship fostering activities that lay the foundation for establishing healthy and rewarding bonds with diverse individuals and groups.

Self-Management

Giving students the opportunity to set goals, manage their time, organize their thinking, and be held accountable for their success.

Decision Making

Calling for students to identify problems, analyze and consider possible solutions, and make knowledge-based decisions on how to preserve through challenges.
