

How to fill out your 5592e RCMP form

Please read the information sheet 5592e RCMP form as it explains the form in detail.

We have added the notes below to assist those who are having a challenge understanding the form as we have had numerous inquiries, so we put together an instructional sheet to assist.

Section A: Should be self-explanatory, fill in the appropriate section which will most likely be only

Section B: Self-explanatory

Section C: Self-explanatory (be honest)

Section D/E/F: Fill in as necessary

Section G:

20.a (**Yes**), this is where you attach one of the (2) stamp Canadian Firearms Safety course paperwork you received back from FSESO.

20.b (**Yes**), this is where you attach one of the (2) stamp Canadian **Restricted** Firearms Safety course paperwork you received back from FSESO.

20.c Unless you “have you been certified by the Chief Firearms Officer as meeting the safety training requirements or have you successfully completed a course approved by the Attorney General of Manitoba or Quebec prior to 1995?” Which most likely you have not answer **No**.

Section H: Fill in as required

Note: A reference is anyone who has known you for at least three (3) years and is at least 18 years old. However, he or she cannot be your current conjugal partner. Make sure you let them know you are using them as a reference and that they maybe called.

Section I: Fill in as required and ensure the back of the photo is signed.

A photo guarantor is a person who confirms that the photograph you supply accurately identifies you. Your photo guarantor must have known you for at least one (1) year and must be at least 18 years old. Your conjugal partner or one of your references may be your photo guarantor. Your photo guarantor must sign below and on the back of the photograph.

Section J: The fee is **\$83.23**, which is the combined fee for both the PAL and RPAL

Section K: Please sign and date your form.
