For over 24 years, Rose has showcased artifacts and other crafts at countless fairs, festivals, tradeshow and museum events symbolic of Africa's rich cultural heritage.

Luangisa African Gallery has been in business for over 24 years. Crafting authentic hand made products in Africa provides a vital employment option for both women and men. We also provide employment for the disadvantaged particularly widows, youth and the disabled. We believe when you give women opportunities, it opens them up to hope and dreams to learn and grow. This learning leads to motivation and doing thus, changing their lives which changes the course of history. This is very important to us especially knowing that the rural African women is the backbone of the family.



We support the Maasai women, Fulani, Tikar and Makonde artisans by giving them access to economic empowerment through fair trade, while preserving their culture and tradition. We make sure artisans showcase their work and can depend on sustainable employment that helps improve their lives and the communities around them.

Inspired by the symbolic cultural significance of the Maasai beaded jewelry, beaded Namji dolls, Tikar beaded artifacts and Makonde sculptures, each piece tells a story and we endeavor to tell the stories and preserve the culture and traditions of these unique tribes.



We believe in building reliable partnerships so talented artisans can sell their handmade creations beyond their local markets. Over the past 24 years, the Luangisa family has helped that relationship and love blossom resulting into appreciative individuals around the world and happy artisans.

The Luangisa Foundation has enabled increased access to health and education services for over 100 children and their families. In November 2018, we shipped a 40 foot container to Tanzania filled up with basic necessities for the children and their families. Donations are welcome. We believe the children are our future!

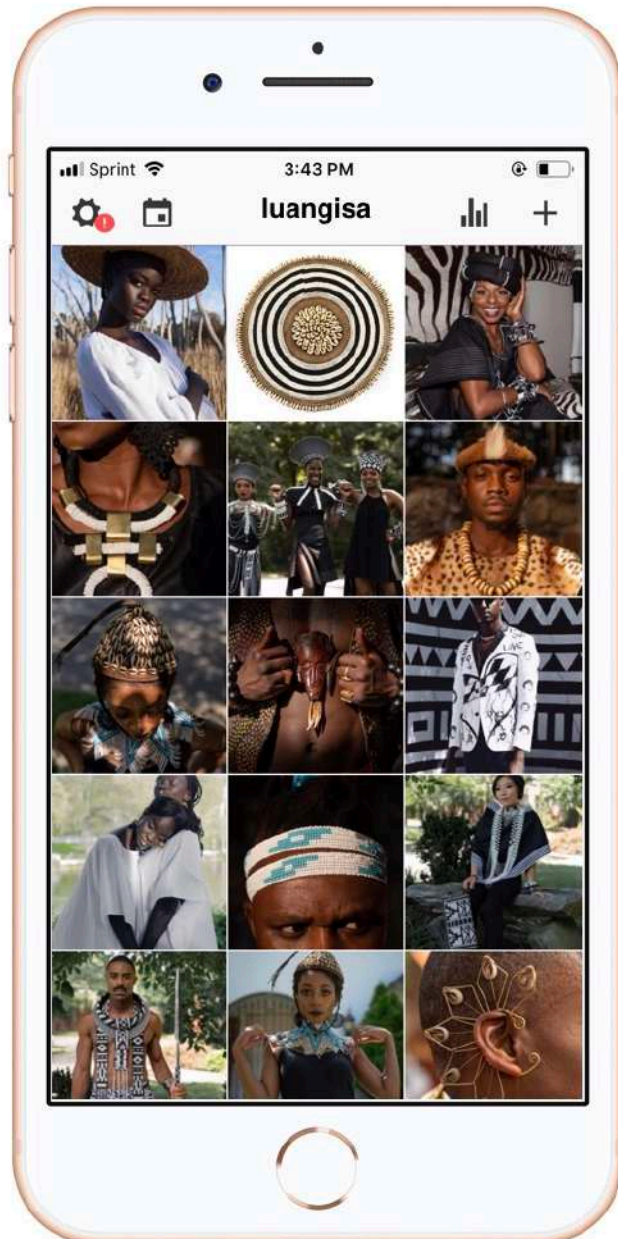
