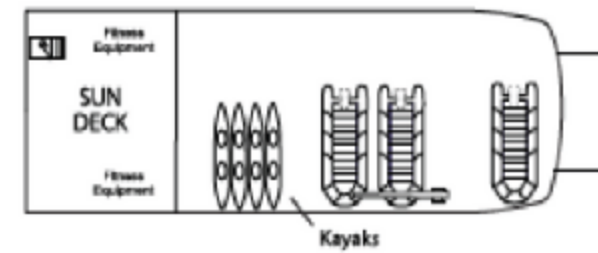


Safari Voyager

Commodore Suite (COM)

Fixed queen bed; sitting area with wet bar; refrigerator; media center; large bow-facing view windows; jetted whirlpool tub; private bath with shower; (sofa bed for triple—suitable for child/teen)



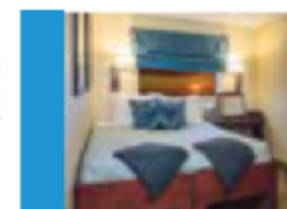
Pathfinder (PAT)

Fixed twin beds; desk and chair; view windows; private bath with shower



Jr Commodore (JCO)

Queen or twin beds; desk and chair; view window; private bath with large shower; (sofa bed for triple)



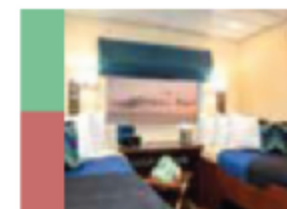
Trailblazer (TRB)

Queen or twin beds; desk and chair; view window; private bath with shower



Admiral (ADM)

Queen or twin beds; desk and chair; view windows; private bath with shower; (youth-sized sofa bed for triple)



Navigator (NAV)

Single Navigator (NAV) Queen or twin beds (MST/NAV); twin bed (SGL); desk and chair; view window; private bath with shower
