

Flower Charm Bracelet

A cute bracelet that is simple to make

Materials: small flower shaped beads - acrylic or glass x9
bead caps x9
headpins x9
links x9
jump rings x10
charm x1
lobster clasp x1



Tools: chain nose pliers
round nose pliers
side cutters
Optional: one step looper

Slide a bead cap and flower bead onto the headpin, fasten and make a loop at the end of the eyepin, and then cut it off the excess headpin.
Make 9 more flowers with bead caps and headpins.



Add a jump ring to attach the flower charm onto the links - two per charm.
Connect all flower charms with the links.



Add a small jump ring to connect a charm to one end of the flower charms;

Add a big jump rings to this end, while add a lobster claw clasp to the other end, then the Flower Charm Bracelet is finished.



Tips

The number of flower beads needed depends on size of the bead and the link used. I have used a 17mm link.

Acrylic beads are lighter than glass so try various types of beads and bead caps to product the look you want.

When making a lot of loops at the end of headpins or eyepins the one step looper saves a lot of time.
