Tray Pendant

Customize pendants using decorative paper, your art work or your own family photos printed on your computer

Materials: glass piece

tray pendant

image (printed on computer paper)

glue

jewellers dot or double sided tape

Tools: scissors

cotton bud



Select an image. Leave as much selvage as possible when cutting out image. Place image on a scrap piece of paper front side up.



Apply glue on flat back of the glass and spread to all four corners. You want to do this liberally.



Place the glass glue side down onto the front of your image and press down. Once pressed down, move to where you want it. The glue will ooze out all around the glass. Use the cotton bud to wipe up the glue that has oozed out around the edges of the glass.



Let the glue dry completely. Trim off the excess paper off the edge of the glass piece. Touch the scissors to the edge of the glass piece.



Place the Jewellers Dot or double sided tape to the inside to the tray. Attach the glass to tray and add your chose of stringing material.

String on your chain or necklace and you are done.

Tips

Try any image. Use untrimmed paper

Try decorative scrapbook papers

You can use photos or images from your computer but you have to print on computer paper (not photo paper or cardstock).

Be aware if your printer has waterproof ink or not, as you my have a mess unless you spray your image with fixative. Nail polish or varnish (non yellowing) to seal

Clean your glass to remove any dust or particles, try using a lint free cloth.

Use a glue that dries clear.

Avoid shaking the glue otherwise bubbles will form. Use even strong pressure when glueing as this will remove any bubbles.

Coat the back of the image completely.

Use sharp scissors and wait for paper to dry completely before trimming.

If your image doesn't work, reuse the glass by placing it in hot water and let it sit until the image comes off. Then try again
