



DIY0051 – DIY Miyuki Delica Colorblock Necklace with Griffin Cord

- (1) SB00141 11/0 Galvanized Silver Miyuki Delica Seed Beads Tube
- (1) SB02339 11/0 Underwater Blue Duracoat Opaque Dyed Delica Seed Beads
- (1) SB00229 DB206 11/0 Opaque Salmon Miyuki Delica Seed Beads Tube
- (1) SB00259 DB351 11/0 Matte White Miyuki Delica Seed Beads Tube
- (1) A006574 Griffin Bead Cord 100% Silk - No. 4 (0.60mm) Light Pink

Tool Suggestions:

Directions

1. Unravel silk cord from its card and straighten out the cord with water.
2. Make a knot at the end of the silk cord.
3. Slide on 4 delicas and make another knot, close to the last delica.
4. Slide on a delica bead. (This will act as your slider piece at the end).
5. Slide on 1.5 to 2 inches of 1st delica beads.
6. Alternate the 1st and 2nd delicas 5 to 6 times.
7. Slide on 1.5 to 2 inches of 2nd delica beads.
8. Alternate the 2nd and 3rd delicas 5 to 6 times.
9. Slide on 1.5 to 2 inches of 3rd delica beads.
10. Alternate the 3rd and 4th delicas 5 to 6 times.
11. Slide on 1.5 to 2 inches of 4th delica beads.
12. Alternate the 3rd and 4th delicas 5 to 6 times.
13. Slide on 1.5 to 2 inches of 3rd delica beads.
14. Alternate the 2nd and 3rd delicas 5 to 6 times.
15. Slide on 1.5 to 2 inches of 2nd delica beads.
16. Alternate the 1st and 2nd delicas 5 to 6 times.
17. Slide on 1.5 to 2 inches of 1st delica beads.
18. slide needle through delica you added in step 4. You're going to make a loop, so feed needle through the side that has the silk cord end.

19. Put necklace on to determine the length you would like your necklace. Necklace in sample is 38" long. It can be adjusted to be shorter too.
20. Make a knot at the other cord end. Slide on 4 delicas and make another knot close to the last delica. Cut off excess silk cord.
