



DIY0064 - DIY Grey Acetate and Silver Crescent Charm Easy Leather Necklace

Tool Suggestions:

Chain Nose Pliers  
Scissors



Components List

- Z010959 - 3mm Slate Grey Deerskin Lace - 2 Yards
- Z008275 - 50mm Bright .999 Fine Silver Plated Flat Grande Hoop by Nunn Designs
- Z016775 - 33mm Antique Silver Hanging Crescent Connector Charm
- Z007250 - 24mm Grey Acetate Coin Charm
- X003062 - 5.5mm Silver Plated 18 Gauge Round Jump Rings - 25 Pack
- A008807 - 7mm Silver Plated 16 Gauge Round Jump Rings - 25 Pack

Directions:

1. Open small jump ring (X003062), slide on acetate charm and attach to the bottom of the silver crescent. Close jump ring.
2. Open larger jump ring (A008807), slide through the top hole of silver crescent. Close jump ring.
3. Open another larger jump ring (A008807), attach to the jump ring from Step 2 and close jump ring.
4. Cut deer skin leather lace to desired length. We suggest a minimum of 36 inches which will make an approximately 18 inch necklace. Note\* - there is no clasp on this design. Just an overhand knot so you will want to make sure you can easily slip it over your head.
5. Fold the leather in half, slide looped end through Large Open Frame Hoop and jump ring from Step 3. Make a lark's head knot. Do not pull too hard on the leather as it can break if pull too hard.
6. Make an overhand knot to both ends of the leather together.
