Directions:

- 1. Open small jump ring (X003062), slide on acetate charm and attach to the bottom of the silver crescent. Close jump ring.
- 2. Open larger jump ring (A008807), slide through the top hole of silver crescent. Close jump ring.
- 3. Open another larger jump ring (A008807), attach to the jump ring from Step 2 and close jump ring.
- 4. Cut deer skin leather lace to desired length. We suggest a minimum of 36 inches which will make an approximately 18 inch necklace. Note* there is no clasp on this design. Just an overhand knot so you will want to make sure you can easily slip it over your head.
- 5. Fold the leather in half, slide looped end through Large Open Frame Hoop and jump ring from Step 3. Make a lark's head knot. Do not pull too hard on the leather as it can break if pull too hard.
- 6. Make an overhand knot to both ends of the leather together.
