



## DIY0080 DIY Silver Botanical Branch + Leaf Necklace

### Components List

- ☐ (1) A011534 10mm Silver-Plated Lobster Claws
- ☐ (1) A019631 2 Inch Silver Plated 20 Gauge Eyepins
- ☐ (1) TC01020 19mm Antique Silver Violet Leaf Charm by Tierracast
- ☐ (1) TC02402 36mm Antique Silver Botanical Branch Link by TierraCast
- ☐ (1) A001528 5mm Silver Plated 20 Gauge Round Jump Rings
- ☐ (2) CH01095 2.2mm Silver Plated Tiny Oval Chain
- ☐ (1) RBP8RDLH-8 Rocky Butte Large Hole 8mm Round - 8-inch

### Tool Suggestions:

- Two Flat or Chain Nose Pliers
- Side Cutter
- Looper Pliers (optional)

### Directions

1. Cut chain to desired length. This design uses a 16.5" chain.
2. Gently open a 4mm jump ring with chain nose pliers. Slide one lobster clasp onto a 4mm jump ring and close it.
3. Gently open and close a 5mm jump ring on the opposite end of the chain.)
4. Fold the chain in half, bringing the side with the 5mm jump ring up approximately 1.5" higher than the side with the lobster clasp for measurement purposes of the next steps.
5. Measure approximately 1.5" on the lobster clasp side and make a cut using the side cutter
6. Gently open two 4mm jump rings and one 5mm jump ring with chain nose pliers. Place the Antique Silver Botanical Branch Link between the separated/cut chain and connect the branch link to the chain on the end closest to the lobster clasp using one of the two 4mm jump rings. Connect the other 4mm jump ring to the branch link end that is closest to the middle of the necklace. Connect this 4mm jump ring to one 5mm jump ring and, before closing this 5mm jump ring, connect it to the end of the chain that is the middle of the necklace.
7. Gently open the loop end of an eyepin and attach the Antique Silver Violet Leaf Charm. Close the eye of the pin.
8. Place three Rocky Butte Large Hole 8mm Round beads on the straight part of the eye pin and, using a side cutter, cut above the bead, leaving enough space to make a loop/eye.
9. Make a loop at the top of the eyepin, similarly to the other eye of the eyepin, by gently grasping the pin with a chain nose pliers and wrapping the pin around, making a circle. Or, use a looper pliers to create this loop.
10. Before closing this side of the pin, attach this pin to the 5mm jump ring at the center of the chain and gently close the pin.
