Tool Suggestions:	
-Scissors -Plastic Drinking Straw – cut to about 1.5″	

Directions:

1. Tie a knot at one end of the length of leather cord. Don't cut the cord. The full 2 meters are used until the bracelet is completed.



2. Slide on 1-8mm stone beads. Tie a knot right after the bead to keep the bead in place.


3. Tie the next knot about 1 "down from the stopping bead knot.



4. Slide on the Shank Button and tie another knot right after the shank to keep the button in place



5. Start the Whip Knot (which is also a sliding knot). Pinch the leather just past the button edge and follow the diagram below.



Pinch straw on top of the cross u loop.






Hold straw piece in place and wrap the leather around the straw and the leather. Wrap from the top of the loop towards the button. Wrap 4 times.

You are working with the full length of leather so go slowly. As you start to wrap the 5th rotation, take the leather tip of the leather and pass it through the center of the straw. Gently pull out the straw and place the leather tip down through the leather loop. (E) Now gradually pull the length of the leather so the leather loops tighten up. With your fingers keep the loops parallel to each other. You do not want the loops crossing on top of each other.



6. You have completed the slider whip knot, now add 1- spacer disk, followed by the 8mm stone bead and lastly add 1 more spacer disk. Repeat the process from A - E.





 End the bracelet with a loop. There are two ways to finish the bracelet.
A. Finish with a loop that fits the button width and just knot. Knot and place the fringe bead add a placement knot to hold the bead in place. Clip excess leather.
