Directions:

- 1. You will receive 2 feet of beading chain. Cut to your desired length. For example, if you want a necklace that is 18" long, cut the chain at 17.5". The crimp ends and clasp will account for about another 0.5 inch.
- 2. Add a very small amount of glue to one end of the beading chain. Slide the chain through the Crimp End with Loop.
- 3. Using your flat nose pliers, flatten the crimp tube. You may need to apply a fair amount of pressure.
- 4. Start sliding on your beads. You will start with a blue Delica and use a gold Delica to as a space for each dot and dash. This is how STRONG will look:

5. Once you have all your beads on, repeat steps 2 and 3.

6. Using one of the jump rings, add the clasp to one of the crimp loops.

7. Add another jump ring to the other crimp loop.

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
