



DIY0188 DIY Frosty Howlite Stretch Bracelet

**Components List**

- (1) **Z020137** - Festive Holiday Charm 3 piece Set in Rhodium Plating
- (1) **WHT10RD-8** - White Howlite 10mm Round 8-Inch
- (1) **Y012009** - 12mm Antique Silver Bali Style Large Hole Donut Beads - 5 Pack
- (1) **A021461** - 9mm Brushed Silver Plated Bali Style Large Hole Round Beads
- (1) **Z002389** - 12mm Silver Plated Rhinestone Ring with Loop
- (1) **Z007856** - 3mm Silver Plated 22 Gauge Round Jump Rings - 50 Pack
- (1) **Z002903** - .7mm Stretch Magic Elastic Cord (5 Meters)
- (1) **Z001464** - Beadalon Big Eye Beading Needle - 4 Pack

**Tools Needed:**

- Chain Nose Pliers

**Directions:**

**Step 1.** Attach a jump ring to the tree charm, close the jump ring.

**Step 2.** Using another jump ring, attach the tree charm with the jump ring on it to the loop on the rhinestone ring.

**Step 3.** Cut 2.5 feet of the Stretch Magic elastic, and pre-stretch the elastic before stringing by pulling both ends and smaller sections.

**Step 4.** Cut the tip of one of the Big Eye Beading needles so that it is open and shaped like a "V". You will be able to easily slide the needle off the elastic and be able to reuse the needle for future elastic bracelets.

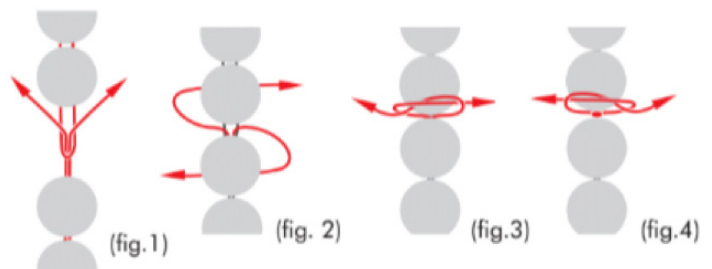
**Step 5.** Fold elastic in half and slide needle on at that midpoint.

**Step 6.** Slide the beads onto the elastic:

- a. Two round silver beads
- b. Two Howlite beads
- c. One round silver bead
- d. Two Howlite beads
- e. One silver rondelle bead
- f. One Howlite bead
- g. One silver rondelle bead
- h. One Howlite bead
- i. Rhinestone ring with tree charm on it
- j. One Howlite bead
- k. One silver rondelle bead
- l. One Howlite bead
- m. One silver rondelle bead
- n. Two Howlite beads
- o. One round silver bead
- p. Two Howlite beads
- q. Two round silver beads

**Step 7.** Slide the needle off the elastic and follow the Ricky's Knot to tie the elastic.

- a. Take elastic ends and feed it through the loop of the elastic. (fig. 1)
- b. Take elastic ends and wrap behind elastic loop going in opposite directions. (fig. 2)
- c. Bring both elastic ends forward and tie an overhand knot going right over left. (fig. 3)
- d. Tie a second knot going left over right. (fig. 4)



**Step 8.** Cut off excess elastic leaving an 1/8" or 1/4" end.

**Step 9.** Optional - you can add a little drop of glue to the know for extra security.
