



DIY0218 DIY Rhombus Czech Glass Bead Earrings - Silver and Lavender

**Components List**

**Tools Needed:**

- Chain Nose Pliers
- Round Nose Pliers
- Flush Cutter
- Heavy Duty Cutter (for the steel chain)

- (2) **Z016674** - 43mm Antique Silver Etched Round Hoop
- (1) **Z016755** - 14mm Antique Silver Faceted Teardrop Post Earring with Loop
- (1) **CH00313** - 7mm Silver Plated Flat Curb Chain Link
- (1) **A008807** - 7mm Silver Plated 16 Gauge Round Jump Rings - 25 Pack
- (1) **A019685** - 1.5 Inch Silver Plated Headpins 20 Gauge with Ball Top
- (1) **Z013093** - 20x8mm Rhombus Czech Glass Beads - Thistle with Etched and Picasso Finishes

**Directions:**

1. Cut your chain to desired length. In the design pictured, Heidi uses 7 links of the curb chain per earring.
2. Slide one of the Rhombus Czech glass beads on to one of the head pins. Trim and make a simple loop or wrap loop.
3. Using a jump ring, attach the Rhombus bead to one end of the chain.
4. Using another jump ring, attach the other end of the chain to the loop on the hoop.
5. Using another jump ring, attach one of the post earrings to the loop on the hoop.
6. Position the chain so it is dangling behind the hoop.
7. Repeat steps for the other earring.
