Tools Needed:

- Chain Nose Pliers
- Round Nose Pliers
- Flush Cutter
- Heavy Duty Cutter (for the
- steel chain)

Directions:

1. Cut your chain to desired length. In the design pictured, Heidi uses 7 links of the curb chain per earring.

- 2. Slide one of the Rhombus Czech glass beads on to one of the head pins. Trim and make a simple loop or wrap loop.
- 3. Using a jump ring, attach the Rhombus bead to one end of the chain.
- 4. Using another jump ring, attach the other end of the chain to the loop on the hoop.
- 5. Using another jump ring, attach one of the post earrings to the loop on the hoop.
- 6. Position the chain so it is dangling behind the hoop.
- 7. Repeat steps for the other earring.
