



DIY0220 DIY Leather Bangle Bracelet Duo

Components List

- (10) **CH01243** - 10mm Mediterranean Suede Leather - Dark Teal
- (10) **CH01080** - 10mm Multi-Colored Shimmer Flat Leather
- (1) **Z001462** - Gold Plated Bangle with Twist Off Bezel
- (1) **Z001459** - Rhodium Plated Bangle with Twist Off Bezel

Tools Needed:

- Sharp scissors to cut leather or an exacto knife
- Glue - we recommend using Loctite glue (Z007890)
- Nylon jaw pliers - you can use your hands but the nylon jaw pliers were very helpful in getting the leather into the channel of the bracelet.

Directions:

1. Before gluing the leather into the channel of the bangle, we suggest you first put it in the channel and cut the access leather, or you can do this at the end after you glue.
2. Add a thin layer of the Loctite glue to the leather. A little goes a long way so don't use too much! We applied it in a zigzag pattern and did a little as we went along - not adding it the whole piece of leather at once.
3. Take your time when putting the leather into the channel of the bangle. We would put an inch or two in, then press it down into the channel, then add glue to the next inch or two and then press down into the channel, until your ends meet. You will have a seam in the leather. Using sharp scissors or exacto knife will help minimize the appearance of the seam.
4. Wait for the glue to set before wearing.
