



Start treatment - Press and release the treatment switch to start energy delivery. The LED will start blinking.

Make sure all of the active tip area is in full contact

with the skin during treatment, while maintaining a reasonable, comfortable circular movement speed. When the optimal treatment skin temperature has been reached, the LED on the NEWA changes from blue to green. If you feel that your skin temperature is too high, simply increase the size of the circular motion during treatment.

Do not stop the circular movement of the device

To stop a treatment before the 4 minute end time, just press the power button.

Move to the next treatment area - When treatment of the first area is completed (a total of 4 minutes treatment time), the LED will stop blinking and the device will vibrate to indicate that energy delivery has stopped.

Apply more NEWA Gel on the active tip area, continue to the next treatment area and repeat the procedure.

Complete your skincare routine - Gently remove any excess treatment gel from your face. Cleanse your face thoroughly, than apply any skincare cream of your choice.

Before you begin, follow the instructions below and treat your forearm first to see how your skin reacts to NEWA.

2. Choose your treatment areas

Divide your face into 6 "treatment areas": two on each upper cheek, two on each lower cheek/jawline, and two under the chin.

3. Prepare yourself for the treatment

- Remove all jewelry from the treatment areas. This includes earrings, necklaces or rings.
- Thoroughly clean and dry your face. Make sure all make-up and creams have been removed from the treatment area.





Connect the power supply to the power supply connector on the device and plug it into an electrical outlet. Remove the cover.




Apply two thick "lines" of the NEWA Gel directly onto

Turn ON the device - Move the Power Level Switch to "2". The LED will emit a steady light. We recommend you start with the High heating level (level "2"), but if you find the sensation uncomfortable, you may select the lower power level (level "1").



- Do not use the device if it is disassembled, cracked or if the electric cord is damaged.
- Do not use the device in the vicinity of inflammable liquids (alcohol, acetone).
- Always thoroughly dry your hands and face before treatment.

- Keep out of reach of children.
- Do not place, store or use the device near sources of water such as the sink or bathtub. If the device is wet or falls into water don't touch the device. Unplug the power supply from the electrical outlet immediately.
- Immediately after use, or before cleaning the device, always turn the device off and unplug it from the electrical outlet.
- Only use the power supply supplied with the NEWA to use the device. Using different power supply can damage it.

- Have an implanted pacemaker, arrhythmias or any other severe known heart disorder. (Flow of electrical energy through the body may damage the
- Have any implantable metal device or body piercing in the treatment area. (Flow of electrical energy through the implanted metal may heat the object and cause burns).
- Are pregnant or breastfeeding. (Safety and effectiveness of the device was not tested)
- Suffer from autoimmune disorders or diabetes. (Skin healing in these cases may be impaired)
- Have Cancer of any type

- Taking any drugs that affect skin sensitivity (it may affect heat sensation, or increase skin sensitivity to heat and may cause overheating and burns.
- Have blood clotting disorders
- Use blood thinning medications. (The mechanical massage by the device may induces skin hematomas)

- Do not use the NEWA® over eyelids, eyebrows, lips, ears, breasts or genital area. – the skin in these areas is delicate and sensitive and might be overheated.
- Do not use the device on red, irritated, inflamed or infected skin - the treatment may worsen these symptoms. Discontinue use if irritation occurs.
- Do not use the NEWA® without the supplied treatment gel. The device may not operate properly if used without the Newa® treatment gel, or if used with another lotion or gel.
- Do not turn on the Newa device when the device is not in use. This includes instances when the Newa device is resting on a table or any other flat surface.

 During the treatment, while the device is on (LED is flashing) you should continue to move the Newa™ in a circular motion on the skin. Once movement is stopped during treatment, the skin may overheat and burns can occur.
