Good news for those who do not file a tax return: The IRS has launched a new web tool that enables them to provide information in order to receive their CARES Act stimulus payment.

For taxpayers who filed income tax returns for 2018 or 2019, their stimulus payments will be sent automatically, so they do not need to provide additional information.

Taxpayers receiving Social Security, SSDI and/or railroad retirement benefits are to receive payments based on information supplied by the paying organization to the IRS. However, those with qualifying children under age 17 can use the web site to claim the \$500 payment per child.

Those who receive supplemental security income (SSI) benefits or veterans disability compensation, pension or survivor benefits from the Department of Veterans Affairs should not have to file a simple return. However, the IRS is still exploring ways that payments can be made to those individuals. Persons in these groups can either use the new web tool or wait until the IRS develops a payment option.

Those individuals who did not file tax returns for either 2018 or 2019 can upload their simplified return information and apply for the stimulus payment at <a href="https://www.irs.gov/coronavirus/non-filers-enter-payment-info-here">https://www.irs.gov/coronavirus/non-filers-enter-payment-info-here</a>. Once on the site, click on the blue section.
