- 1 Lightly dig over and rake the soil to prepare a fine, firm seedbed, free of weeds and grass. Or fill pots with soil.
- 2 Scatter the seeds at a rate of 1.5g per square metre over your prepared seedbed or onto pots.
- 3 Press the seeds into the soil using your foot, hand or roller to create good soil-to-seed contact.
- 4 Water lightly and take care not to wash the seeds away.
