## **Products Needed for Project**

Don't be fooled by imitators!



1 yd of pearl-like trim for edge no wider than 4.00mm 1/8yd bridal fabric (bridal satin recommended) 1/8vd bridal lace Powdered fusing.

High quality embroidery thread for edging and monograms.









- Print this PDF pattern onto a plain piece of InkJet paper.
- Cut 1 heart shape of double sided fusible low loft batting.
- Cut slightly larger than the lettering for Bride and Groom of Stick and Rinse Stabilizer as illustrated with the

making sure the

Tape with matte side facing UP using regular tape on leading and following edges as shown here tape doesn't cover over the lettering. Buide



below.

Cut a square of fabric wider than the heart on all sides

Cut a lace piece for applying by fusing onto fabric



narrower on all side than fabric yet wide enough to cover both

and twice as wide to fuse on both sides of the heart shaped

sides of the 1-heart shaped batting.



- Lay wet lace up-side down onto freezer paper or wax paper.
- Sprinkle fusible powder evenly onto lace.



- Lay lace with right side up onto right side of bridal fabric chosen.
- Iron it with a Teflon pressing sheet over the lace on medium heat with no steam. The lace will steam until water has evaporated.
- Cut lace adorned bridal fabric in half.
- Lay pattern under laced fabric and using a light box or window position Bride and Groom stickers onto heart.
- Apply **Stick and Tear** stabilizer to back of medium or large Octi-Hoop frame.
- Apply Laced fabric with stickers onto Stick and Tear and Monogram using high quality thread of choice. Use 90/14 Universal or Stretch needle and match color of thread in bobbin or use close to color in bobbin if using a bobbin thread. Be sure to not rotate hoop while sewing and use a 3.0mm wide width with feed dogs lowered if possible and no presser foot. Be sure to lower your foot despite not using one or you'll get messing stitching on bottom and your machine may jam.
- Iron one side of heart shaped piece.
- Accurately cut laced fabric around heart shaped batting.
- Iron other side and cut accurately again.
- Satin stitch around heart using the Satinedge foot using a with of 3.5mm-4.0mm and approximately .05mm Length.
- Be sure to overlap beginning and tie a knot at end using a knot stitch on your machine or switch to a straight stitch and back
- Attach Pearl trim to edge of heart using the Pearls N Piping foot securing ends by changing to straight stitch or using knot stitch. Use a width wider than the trim - the width can be much wider and use same thread chosen for edging or Invisible thread. .004 Nylon recommended.
