The Serenity requires an ash floor protector to AS/NZS 2918:2001 – ie. a floor protector consisting of a continuous, durable, noncombustible upper surface.


Clearances


Ash floor protector: The minimum height from the fire base (which is the bottom of the metal canopy that encases the fire) to the ash floor protector is 150mm. This distance can be greater provided the ceiling distance is not compromised.

Ceiling: The minimum height from the fire base to the ceiling is 1700mm.

Mantel installation: The minimum clearance from the mantel underside to the fire base is 1180mm for a heat sensitive mantel that is no greater than 200mm deep and has a Firenzo mantel heat deflector fitted.

Side pillar clearances: The minimum clearance from the side of the fascia to any heat sensitive material is 5mm. The pillar must not protrude more than 150mm.




