xNasozi Spring/Summer 2016 is all about [de]construction. We're picking apart and putting back together the timeless elements of African textile design that have inspired us from Day 1. What we've come up with is a completely original and contemporary collection inspired by our timeworn allegiance to mudcloth, aka BOGOLAN, an artisinal textile tradition from Mali, West Africa.

Founder and creative director Nasozi Kakembo has worked almost exclusively with African and Dutch wax prints, Malian mudcloth, and various applications of west African indigo since she launched her first collection in Spring of 2011. Her relationship with these expressions of identity and culture is one of deference and tuition.

xNasozi proudly presents its first and very own collection of completely original works, aptly named *BOGOLAN [DE]CONSTRUCTED.*

Each cover starts out as untreated woven cotton, made in Mali. Pillow manufacturing and design happens in Brooklyn, NY. Only natural and non-toxic paints are used.
